the emergence of tropical medicine in france examines the turbulent history of the ideas people and institutions of french colonial and tropical medicine from their early modern origins through world war i until the 1890s colonial medicine was in essence naval medicine taught almost exclusively in a system of provincial medical schools built by the navy in the port cities of brest rochefort sur mer toulon and bordeaux michael a osborne draws out this separate species of french medicine by examining the histories of these schools and other institutions in the regional and municipal contexts of port life each site was imbued with its own distinct sensibilities regarding diet hygiene ethnicity and race all of which shaped

medical knowledge and practice in complex and heretofore unrecognized ways osborne argues that physicians formulated localized concepts of diseases according to specific climatic and meteorological conditions and assessed diagnosed and treated patients according to their ethnic and cultural origins he also demonstrates that regions more so than a coherent nation built the empire and specific medical concepts and practices thus by considering tropical medicine s distinctive history osborne brings to light a more comprehensive and nuanced view of french medicine medical geography and race theory all the while acknowledging the navy s crucial role in combating illness and investigating the racial dimensions of health

most monumental buildings of france s global empire such as the famous saigon and hanoi opera houses were built in south and southeast asia much of this architecture and the history of who built it and how has been overlooked the architecture of empire considers the large scale public architecture associated with french imperialism in seventeenth and eighteenth century india siam and vietnam and nineteenth and twentieth century indochina the largest colony france ever administered in asia offering a sweeping panorama of the buildings of france s colonial project this is the first study to encompass the architecture of both the ancien régime and modern empires from the founding of the french trading company in the seventeenth century to the independence and nationalist movements of the mid twentieth century gauvin bailey places particular emphasis on the human factor the people who commissioned built and lived in these buildings almost all of these architects both europeans and non europeans have remained unknown beyond at best their surnames through extensive archival research this book reconstructs their lives providing vital background for the buildings themselves much more than in the french empire of the western hemisphere the buildings in this book adapt to indigenous styles regardless of whether they were designed and built by european or non european architects the architecture of empire provides a unique comprehensive study of structures that rank among the most fascinating examples of intercultural exchange in the history of global empires

though michel foucault is one of the most important thinkers of the twentieth century little is known about his early life even foucault s biographers have neglected this period preferring instead to start the story when the future philosopher arrives in paris becoming foucault is a historical reconstruction of the world in which foucault grew up the small city of poitiers france from the 1920s until the end of the second world war beyond exploring previously

unexamined aspects of foucault s childhood including his wartime ordeals it proposes an original interpretation of foucault s oeuvre michael behrent argues that foucault in addition to being a theorist of power knowledge and selfhood was also a philosopher of experience he was a thinker intent on making sense of the events that he lived through behrent identifies four specific experiences in foucault s childhood that exercised a decisive influence on him and that in various ways he later made the subject of his philosophy his family s deep connections to the medical profession his upbringing in a bourgeois household the german occupation during world war ii and his catholic education behrent not only reconstructs the specific nature of these experiences but also shows how reference to them surfaces in foucault s later work in this way the book both sheds light on a formative period in the philosopher s life and offers a unique interpretation of key aspects of his thought
