when edward Śmigly rydz appeared on its september 1939 cover time magazine described him as a scholar technician graceful versatile serious with a professor s inquisitive mind this was the man who was leading poland s resistance to hitler s invasion an impoverished orphan he had risen to his country s highest military rank admonishing his people to the germans we would lose our freedom to the russians we would lose our souls in 1920 he had led a maneuver which defeated a westward surge by russia s red army and had humiliated joseph stalin but in 1939 hitler and stalin combined to overrun poland interned Śmigly rydz escaped and despite a widespread manhunt eluded his pursuers in the end he left behind a cryptic poem all around me are pensive crosses black from smoke he also left behind a secret which undermined germany s war effort and fostered hitler s own defeat dr archibald patterson holds degrees from harvard and three other american universities north carolina southern methodist and georgia he has been assistant director and operations manager government accountability office gao and associate professor troy state university europe where he taught for six years principally in germany but as far a field as turkey he was born in california and lives now in tennessee

the intelligence war between germany and the soviet union ignited by operation barbarossa on 22 june 1941 was fiercely contested over four years neither side was prepared for the scale of the conflict and both quickly developed methods to assess and counter each other s military intentions this book explores the intelligence strategies of stalin s smersh and hitler s abwehr smersh coordinated three independent counter intelligence agencies within the red army while the abwehr was germany s military intelligence service focusing on key battles like stalingrad and kursk the book examines how both sides competed for intelligence advantage the soviets excelled in strategic deception manipulating german decision making early in the war they used counterintelligence to deceive the germans notably during their surprise counteroffensive at moscow in december 1941 and their hidden tank formations in 1942 german intelligence chief gehlen underestimated soviet deception and overestimated german superiority which hindered effective analysis meanwhile the soviets deployed agents behind german lines and employed terror tactics to destroy german operations the pivotal battle of stalingrad revealed the germans intelligence failures and

their subsequent losses marked a turning point by the war's end soviet counterintelligence had become a critical weapon reshaping the intelligence landscape and significantly impacting the outcome of the war

in 1940 the us army signal intelligence service broke the japanese diplomatic code in 1975 oshima hiroshi japan's ambassador to berlin during world war ii died never knowing that the hundreds of messages he transmitted to tokyo had been fully decoded by the americans and whisked off to washington providing a major source of information for the allies on nazi activities

challenging previous accounts megargee shatters the myth that german generals would have prevailed in world war ii if only hitler had not meddled in their affairs instead he observes that the military's strategic ideas were no better than hitler's and often were worse 20 photos

it seemed that whenever mussolini acted on his own it was bad news for hitler indeed the fuhrer's relations with his axis partners were fraught with an almost total lack of coordination compared to the allies the coalition was hardly an alliance at all focusing on germany's military relations with italy romania hungary and finland richard dinardo unearths a wealth of information that reveals how the axis coalition largely undermined hitler's objectives from the eastern front to the balkans mediterranean and north africa dinardo argues that the axis military alliance was doomed from the beginning by a lack of common war aims the absence of a unified command structure and each nation's fundamental mistrust of the others germany was disinclined to make the kinds of compromises that successful wartime partnerships demanded and because hitler insisted on separate pacts with each nation italy and finland often found themselves conducting counterproductive parallel wars on their own dinardo's detailed assessments of ground naval and air operations reveal precisely why the axis allies were so dysfunctional as a collective force

sometimes for seemingly mundane but vital reasons a shortage of interpreters for example his analysis covers coalition warfare at every level demonstrating that some military services were better at working with their allies than others while also pointing to rare successes such as rommel s effective coordination with italian forces in north africa in the end while some individual axis units fought with distinction if not on a par with the vaunted wehrmacht and helped germany achieve some of its military aims the coalition s overall military performance was riddled with disappointments breaking new ground dinardo s work enlarges our understanding of germany s defeat while at the same time offering a timely reminder of the challenges presented by coalition warfare

illuminate this transformation and the callous organizational culture that emerged purged of dissidents indoctrinated to idolize hitler and trained in military combat these police battalions often numbering several hundred men repeatedly conducted actions against jews slavs gypsies asocials and other groups on their own initiative even when they had the choice not to in addition to documenting these atrocities westermann examines cooperation between the ordnungspolizei and the ss and gestapo and the close relationship between police and wehrmacht in the conduct of the anti partisan campaign of annihilation throughout westermann stresses the importance of ideological indoctrination and organizational initiatives within specific groups it was the organizational culture of the uniformed police he maintains and not german culture in general that led these men to commit genocide hitler s police battalions provides the most complete and comprehensive study to date of this neglected branch of himmler s ss and police empire and adds a new dimension to our understanding of the holocaust and the war on the eastern front

they were foot soldiers and officers they served in the regular army and the waffen ss and remarkably they were also jewish at least as defined by hitler s infamous race laws pursuing the thread he first unraveled in hitler s jewish soldiers bryan rigg takes a closer look at the experiences of wehrmacht soldiers who were classified as jewish in this long awaited companion volume he presents interviews with twenty one of these men whose stories are both fascinating and disturbing as many as 150 000 jews and partial jews or mischlinge served often with distinction in the german military during world war ii the men interviewed for this volume portray a wide range of experiences some came from military families some had been raised christian revealing in vivid detail how they fought for a government that robbed them of their rights and sent their relatives to extermination camps yet most continued to serve since resistance would have cost them their lives and they mistakenly hoped that by their service they could protect themselves and their families the interviews recount the nature and extent of their dilemma the divided loyalties under which many toiled during the nazi years and afterward and their sobering reflections on religion and the holocaust including what they knew about it at the time rigg relates each individual s experiences following the establishment of hitler s race laws shifting between vivid

scenes of combat and the increasingly threatening situation on the home front for these men and their family members their stories reveal the constant tension in their lives how some tried to hide their identities and how a few were even aryanized as part of hitler s effort to retain reliable soldiers including field marshal erhard milch three star general helmut wilberg and naval commander bernhard rogge chilling compelling almost beyond belief these stories depict crises of conscience under the most stressful circumstances lives of hitler s jewish soldiers deepens our understanding of the complex intersection of nazi race laws and german military service both before and during world war ii
