Se trata del primer libro testimonial sobre Ernesto Guevara. El libro se publicó en 1968 a partir de una idea del editor Jorge Álvarez. Fue difundido en todo el mundo y colaboró a forjar el mito del Che Rojo. Fue testigo privilegiado de las circunstancias más importantes de la vida de Guevara. Lo conoció en Bolivia en 1953 cuando ambos eran unos jóvenes en busca de la experiencia latinoamericana. A partir de entonces establecieron una fuerte amistad que incluyó a Celia, la madre de Ernesto. En México asistió a su deslumbramiento con Fidel Castro y los revolucionarios cubanos. Luego del triunfo de la Revolución, lo visitó en la isla en 1961 cuando ya convertido en el Che. Era ministro de Industrias Rojo. Gestiona el mítico encuentro con el presidente argentino Arturo Frondizi. Actúa como abogado de varios sobrevivientes de la Guerrilla de Jorge Masetti y más tarde de Ciro Roberto Bustos, compañero del Che en Bolivia. Lo que le permitió conocer en detalle las circunstancias de la muerte de su amigo Ernesto Rojo. De origen radical, tuvo una vida política muy intensa que lo acercó al Peronismo y lo instaló como articulador del pacto entre Perón y Arturo Frondizi. Desarrolló vínculos con otros líderes e intelectuales latinoamericanos como Fidel Castro, Arturo
