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this book presents a strategy that will help countries reach the goal of having and making the best use of a high quality pool of skills

first published in 1994 the growing interest in work of mentors within school based initial teacher training courses in england and wales is a phenomenon of the recent past the development of innovative schemes within secondary education such as the oxford internship scheme benton 1990 generated a national debate about the nature of partnership between schools and higher education institutions which the government joined when it introduced experimental forms of initial teacher education in the licensed and articulated teacher schemes des 1988 and 1989 these were extensively school based and included both secondary and primary mentor like behaviour may come from many sources within a school and the appointed mentor may engage in such unmentor like activities as making formal summative assessments of students with career shaping implications of passing and failing this volume is an attempt to provide some illumination and indicate some of the central issues to be addressed however we hope that the following chapters will provide an informative base from which to launch research into these and other aspects of primary school student teacher mentoring as well as being of value for those engaged in mentoring and mentor training

this publication highlights new evidence on policies to support job creation bringing together the latest research on labour market entrepreneurship and local economic development policy to help governments support job creation in the recovery

the central theme of the third workshop in part ii six studies are reported wherein novel learning environments for elementary and secondary mathematics education have been designed implemented and evaluated in part iii of the volume another set of five investigations is presented relating to the design implementation and evaluation of powerful learning environments in other subject matter domains physics history social sciences and in teacher training

organizations such as the sierra club and friends of the earth are familiar to anyone with an interest in environmental protection as activist groups they played by the same rules for years but in 1994 the rules changed with the republican takeover of congress environmental groups faced sweeping changes in federal policies that threatened the enforcement of environmental laws as these organizations intensified their efforts to meet these challenges they also altered their electoral strategies and political spending patterns this book traces those actions and shows what they mean for the future of environmentalism in the political arena while environmental advocacy groups have become bigger and better funded in recent years so have the corporate interests that compete with them for the attention of public and politicians the green agenda in american politics offers a new look at environmental advocacy that focuses on contemporary lobbying electioneering and agenda setting in this new context drawing on interviews with activists from a wide range of organizations robert duffy describes what environmental groups actually do when lobbying officials or the public he examines activity at both national and state levels to emphasize their growing use of websites email and action alert networks to conduct more sophisticated

grassroots campaigns and he shows how they are devoting more funds to unregulated forms of spending such as independent expenditure issue advocacy advertising and public education campaigns duffy also tracks emerging trends in interest group politics and provides an overview of activism through the early 1990s he then documents the emergence of more aggressive action after 1994 such as providing campaign services to candidates and mounting voter registration drives he also shows how state and local groups have begun to play more important roles in the wake of the rollback of federal environmental regulations brimming with new insights into interest group lobbies in general and contemporary environmental groups in particular duffy s book opens a new window on the influence of big money in the supposedly democratic electoral process

it is difficult to ignore the fact that even as the united states becomes much more racially and ethnically diverse our neighborhoods remain largely segregated the 1968 fair housing act and 1977 community reinvestment act promised to end discrimination yet for millions of americans housing options remain far removed from the american dream why do most neighborhoods in american cities continue to be racially divided the problem suggests mara sidney lies with the policies themselves she contends that to understand why discrimination persists we need to understand the political challenges faced by advocacy groups who implement them in unfair housing she offers a new explanation for the persistent color lines in our cities by showing how weak national policy has silenced and splintered grassroots activists sidney explains how political compromise among national lawmakers with divergent interests resulted in housing legislation that influenced how community activists defined discrimination what actions they took and which political relationships they cultivated as a result local governments became less likely to include housing discrimination on their agendas existing laws went unenforced and racial segregation continued a former undercover investigator for a fair housing advocacy group sidney takes readers into the neighborhoods of minneapolis and denver to show how federal housing policy actually works she examines how these laws played out in these cities and reveals how they eroded activists capability to force more sweeping reform in housing policy sidney also shows how activist groups can cultivate community resources to overcome these difficulties looking across levels of government to analyze how national policies interact with local politics in the first book to apply policy design theories of anne schneider and helen ingram to an empirical case sidney illuminates overlooked impacts of fair housing and community reinvestment policies and extends their theories to the study of local politics and nonprofit organizations sidney argues forcefully that understanding the link between national policy and local groups sheds light on our failure to reduce discrimination and segregation as battles over fair housing continue her book helps us understand the shape of the battlefield and the prospects for victory

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
