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for much of the twentieth century the definition of success for most community colleges revolved around student retention and graduation this definition no longer works if it ever did in student success in the community college what really works respected community college leaders researchers and innovators argue that student success is about redesigning community colleges in a manner that is consistent with each college s mission goals student population and resources concluding that there is no one size fits all approach to increasing student success chapter authors analyze national state and regional efforts to increase student success identify principles institutions can use to frame student success initiatives and outline specific actions community colleges can take to increase student and institutional success student success in the community college what really works also provides concrete examples of effective student success initiatives in a variety of community college settings

in today s colleges and universities whether students succeed depends in large part on access to effective services that can support and guide them in pursuit of their educational goals policy and practice in the field of student services has been largely based on professional literature from us sources donna hardy cox and carney strange offer the first comprehensive description of professional student services in canadian colleges and universities from the perspective of the practitioner scholars who create and lead them hardy cox and strange begin with an overview of student services dealing with the matriculation of post secondary students through enrolment management financial assistance and orientation to the institution and accommodation and then discuss housing and residence life student leadership programs systems of judicial and academic integrity and student support and adjustment through counseling health and wellness initiatives career and employment advice and a variety of services that can respond to a variety of needs how these services are integrated professionally on campus including their organization and leadership as well as their design within differing institutional contexts and delivery methods is the focus of the closing chapters followed by a distillation of principles that underlie effective student services

as an archetypal student success higher educator myself i did not enter this profession intentionally but my life experiences did prepare me to be very successful at this work so what are those experiences and types of knowledge insight skills that equip one to do this kind of work this book is about encouraging the next generation of successors to use their experiences to become equity

warriors within the system john n gardner this book argues that today more than ever we need new and more student success leaders to step forward to make the changes that students need and it offers the story of one such leader in the belief that it will help others see how they can make their own contribution to this movement the author relates a story about events and individuals that launched a national and international movement to enable many more college students to proceed beyond the beginning college experience and complete the credential they are seeking it is also the author s personal history how he ended up spending his whole life in college and how college can make us wiser and more successful than when we started the journey john gardner brings 55 years of professional experience to telling this story he begins with the story of how colleges can and do introduce students to life changing perspectives and ideas in gardner s case it was a matter of being introduced to the question what is justice and then spending his entire professional life seeking ways to bring justice to underserved college students by making changes from the inside of the higher education system an on line compendium accompanies this book which includes prompts for guided reflection and questions and topics for discussion as well as additional material on the author s background and personal philosophy

the concept of belonging has been increasingly understood as the missing piece in diversity equity and inclusion efforts in higher education this book explores the need to recognize and account for institutional level factors that shape academic belonging

thereby improving student experience and outcomes though recent scholarship has identified several factors that are associated with student belonging in academics there is little research that addresses what faculty can do in concrete terms to promote belonging particularly in the domains where they have the most influence the 12 chapters in this volume introduce readers to an array of collaborative cutting edge efforts to develop pedagogies programs strategies and environments that help students develop academic belonging that is a sense of connection competence and confidence in academic domains this book is written for higher education faculty administrators and researchers who wish to enhance their students sense of academic belonging by taking informed practical measures to make them feel valued and supported
