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scholarship on the west african kingdom of asante is at the leading edge of africanist research in this book t c mccaskie gives a detailed and richly nuanced historical portrait of precolonial asante his delineation of state and society in the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries is centred on an extended analysis of the crucial ritual of the annual kumase odwira festival it is at once a profound historical reconstruction of an african polity and a deeply informed meditation on key asante concepts and ideas throughout the book the asante experience is consistently discussed in a relation to a broad range of historiography and critical theory

james e dellroy or great ezomo the venerable head of the dellroy clan is getting old he has raised his family up to become one of the most powerful families in the u s certainly the most powerful black family and the most dangerous he is a man of tradition like his father and all who came before him and carried on a warrior tradition that goes all the way back to his most revered ancestor and even further but some of these traditions are under stress and his descendants begin to worry him when an obscure african slave dies in a slave revolt he leaves behind a legacy of defiance pride and resistance to his children over the generations many defiant dellroys have met a premature end in america but none of them ever went down easily others survived to continue the line but many bore scars to prove their defiance and continued warrior spirit abiola left three other things behind that would shape the mentality and direction of his descendants his name abiola a small carving of his god and a strict order obeyed faithfully by his children and children s children all the way to the present at all cost never allow my bloodline to be tainted by that of the white man the dellroys don t even marry other black people if they show any signs of white ancestry although the dellroys have mixed with

native americans and even later asians no dellroy of the main bloodline has ever voluntarily mated with a caucasian or at least given birth to a child of one if the opposite occurred not if they wanted to stay a dellroy that is about to change america is now a different place from what it once was and there are those who believe that some practices of the family have long outlived their day but not everyone agrees and there are those who may yet prove them right one of tawanna s sons is about to cross a line that will challenge old ignorance s but at the same time set in motion events that will cause upheaval in the dellroy hierarchy send war drums sounding throughout the african diaspora from harlem to argentina and set the dellroys and their kin on a collision course with one of the most powerful mafia families in the country tawanna dellroy must now earn the name that ezomo gave her all those years ago queen dellroy

originally published in 1975 and reprinted with additional introductory material in 1989 this book provides an in depth account of asante history during the nineteenth century the focus of the book is on the broad political development of asante society concentrating on the material factors which affected the decision making process during various administrations this focus reflects the complex and sophisticated nature of the asante social system a system which had its basis in administrative unity and a core idea of nationhood the text utilizes the abundant archival printed and oral source materials available regarding the asante offering the reader a profound insight into the nature and structure of a remarkable society this is a fascinating book that will be of value to anyone with an interest in african history

these four volumes in this major series provide a single source reference to the status of the field of women s history and to ways that the field can be expanded a basic set for all academic libraries library journal academic newswireberger and white focus on sub saharan africa tracing women s history from earliest times to the present by exploring their place in social economic political and religious life the authors highlight the changing societal position of women through shifts over time in ideas about gender and the connections between women s public and private spheres

this is the simple but powerful biographical story of mensa mensa went to school under the colonial british educational system during the eventful post independence years the profession of his parents who were both teachers put him always on the move but his problems of movement were compounded when the parents divorced eventually he ended up in boarding school and he loved it to death because the alternative was a nonexistent home life the novel captures his life from school to school hopping from home to home it is mostly about boarding school life interlaced with wicked humor a parallel poignant story is the story of kids from broken homes especially the one in which the woman plays the role of the vanished parent

for the first time anthropologist robert edgerton tells the story of the hundred year war from 1807 to 1900 between the british empire and the asante kingdom from the asante point of view in 1817 the first british envoy to meet the king of the asante of west africa was dazzled by his reception a group of 5 000 asante soldiers many wearing immense caps topped with three foot eagle feathers and gold ram s horns engulfed him with a zeal bordering on phrensy shooting muskets into the air the envoy was escorted as no fewer than 100 bands played to the asante king s palace and greeted by a tremendous throng of 30 000 noblemen and soldiers bedecked with so much gold that his party had to avert their eyes to avoid the blinding glare some asante elders wore gold ornaments so massive they had to be supported by attendants but a criminal being lead to his execution hands tied ears severed knives thrust through his cheeks and shoulder blades was also paraded before them as a warning of what would befall malefactors

this first encounter set the stage for one of the longest and fiercest wars in all the european conquest of africa at its height the asante empire on the gold coast of africa in present day ghana comprised three million people and had its own highly sophisticated social political and military institutions armed with european firearms the tenacious and disciplined asante army inflicted heavy casualties on advancing british troops in some cases defeating them they won the respect and admiration of british commanders and displayed a unique willingness to adapt their traditional military tactics to counter superior british technology even well after a british fort had been established in kumase the asante capital the indigenous culture stubbornly resisted europeanization as long as the golden stool the sacred repository of royal power remained in asante hands it was only after an entire century of fighting that resistance ultimately ceased

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this is an engaging and absorbing story of faith and perseverance showing how the ghanaian writer was led by providence through his convoluted and troublesome journey that took him through various west african countries and the middle east to his present home in belgium a keen observer of human suffering and vanity he frequently asks the question what are we after on this earth what indeed is the whole point of existence and what does all our striving after

materialism wealth and security amount to the frequent biblical quotations show how the hand of god was always upon the author protecting him from the wiles of satan

asante identities is an account of life in the asante village of ade beba in west africa during a century of rapid change told as far as possible in the words of the villagers themselves asante is the most intensely studied of all sub saharan african cultures and this book takes asante and african historiography to new levels of reconstruction analysis and understanding this is the most closely focused historical study thus far achieved of african people engaging with issues of selfhood identity and agency in an era that saw the continent fall under european domination key features major contribution to african studies in its historical depth and analytic sophistication a book of wider interest to non africanist historians social scientists and others considers issues of broad and current concern never before studied at this level asante identities is a volume in the international african library series a major monograph series from the international african institute which complements its quarterly periodical africa the premier journal in the field of african studies
