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volume one the gospels and acts with typical thoroughness dr hiebert has produced this volume of his new testament introductions though not a commentary on the gospels and acts the book presents their message along with a discussion of such questions as authorship composition and the synoptic problem practical suggestions on how to study these five books are included the bibliographies and annotated book lists are extremely helpful for pastors teachers and laymen volume two the pauline epistles this is a detailed introduction to all of paul s writings epistles that without question are among the most precious treasures of the christian church dr hiebert discusses the historical circumstances of their writing deals with ethical problems and provides helpful general information on the content and nature of the books themselves discussed in general and separately these epistles are treated in chronological order with emphasis on their eschatology soteriology christology or ecclesiology

c l crouch provides a clear and concise introduction to the complex text of jeremiah readers are introduced to the diverse approaches to the book with attention paid to the way that these approaches differ from but also relate to one another after a brief introduction crouch addresses the formation of the book especially in relation to its hebrew and greek versions the theological interests of the book and the challenges posed by attempts to link these to an actual man jeremiah and the relationship of jeremiah to other biblical prophets crouch focuses clearly on method and on approaches to the text as is the mark of this series this makes the book especially useful for students in the quest to navigate the diverse body of scholarly literature that surrounds this troublesome biblical book

this book introduces the epistles and discusses the different interpretive approaches which have been used to gain a clearer understanding of them an introductory chapter defines the epistles and describes the history of their canonization following chapters are devoted to each of the texts with each chapter including 1 historical cultural background 2 the social scientific context 3 social rhetorical purposes 4 narrative discourse 5 postcolonial and 6 feminist insights and finally 7 theological perspectives at the end of each chapter there are suggestions for further reading and a list of reflection questions several chapters include a section or two considering a particular interpretive issue especially relevant to the particular text after taking up each text lockett considers again whether the epistles are a unified whole or to be heard as individual voices here the book interacts with some of the ideas of rob wall and david nienhuis regarding the various thematic theological connections running through the texts a final chapter takes up the relationship between the pauline epistles and the catholic epistles within the new testament

an introduction to reading biblical wisdom texts is designed for undergraduate students and laypersons who are studying scripture part one poses fundamental questions addressed by the genre of wisdom literature explores definitions of wisdom and folly from the biblical perspective describes the characteristics and forms of wisdom poetry and places israel s wisdom tradition in a wider historical cultural context part two addresses the practical wisdom associated with proverbs treating both the contents and the academic questions that arise parts three and four focus on ecclesiastes and job respectively and on the interpretive

julie woods introduces students to the books of jonah micah and nahum in the old testament by examining the books structures and characteristics she covers the latest biblical scholarship including historical and interpretive issues and focuses in particular on the literary and theological emphases of the texts while also paying attention to the role and characterization of animals nature human civilization the corruption of leadership conflict and warfare and the hope of a world at peace with suggestions of further reading at the end of each chapter this guide is an essential accompaniment to study of the books of jonah micah and nahum

science and an examination of the neoscholastic doctrines considerable information is included on the neoscholastic estimation of various trends in modern philosophy written by one of the very greatest historians of medieval philosophy this book is useful both as a corrective to earlier histories and as an excellent exposition and evaluation of the scholastic position

1 thessalonians provides a fascinating glimpse into the origins and social life of the christ group in the ancient roman city of thessalonike while 2 thessalonians reveals how the community developed at a somewhat later time this guide narrates the story of the founding of the group by considering the social and cultural contexts the literary form the rhetorical strategies the theologies and the reception of the two canonical letters while centering on the texts of 1 and 2 thessalonians themselves ascough draws widely on literary and archaeological data giving particular attention to typical group behaviours among small unofficial associations in the greek and roman period the first four chapters focus on 1 thessalonians from the initial formation of the christ group out of a small association of artisans through to how members negotiated various sorts of relationships with paul and his companions with outsiders in thessalonike and beyond and especially with fellow believers within the group itself the final two chapters turn attention to the shifting circumstances that required a second letter to be written with its focus on disorder and disruption of social practices and theological beliefs the epilogue briefly surveys christianity at thessalonike beyond the 1st century this guide presents an overview of the historical development of the christ group at thessalonike moving beyond treating the canonical letters as simple repositories of theological opinions ascough demonstrates how 1 and 2 thessalonians reveal ordinary life in ancient roman cities in so doing he invites readers to enter the world of one of the many fascinating communities of christ believers in the 1st century of the common era

lester l grabbe provides a concise and up to date introduction to the books of kings covering all the historical and interpretative issues grabbe pays particular attention to how the history of ancient israel can be reconstructed or not as the case may be through the text and introduces students to the key ways of reading the books of kings as religious and political history grabbe takes a chronological approach according to the text and provides overviews of the key periods of israel s history the nature of the deuteronomistic history and how well this theory of authorship stands up in the modern day is considered as well as issues of form and source criticism more broadly grabbe concludes by offering a reflection on the books of kings in theological and hermeneutical perspective which enables students to view not only the historical and textual issues but also broader issues of meaning and significance

this work introduces the reader to the broad theological and chronological sweep of the old testament it covers every book of the old testament in the order in which it appears in the hebrew bible and treats the issues and methods in contemporary interpretations without jargon

the new testament writing known as first peter was probably written at the end of the 1st century ce it is addressed to resident aliens who live as colonial subjects in the roman province of asia minor they are portrayed as a marginalized group who experience harassment and suffering this letter is ascribed to the apostle peter but was probably not written by him it is a rhetorical communication sent from christians in the imperial centre in rome camouflaged as babylon an authoritative letter of advice and admonition to good conduct and subordination in the sphere of colonial provincial life 1 peter is a religious document written a long time ago and in a culture and world that is quite different from our own however as a biblical book it is a part of christianity s sacred scriptures this guide to the letter keeps both of these areas the cultural social and the ethical religious in mind it offers help for understanding the letter as both a document of the 1st century and as sacred scripture that speaks about the religious forces that have shaped christianity and western culture in short this guide seeks to enable readers to read against the grain
