volume 8 of the histories of anthropology annual series the premier series published in the history of the discipline explores national anthropological traditions in britain the united states and europe and follows them into postnational contexts contributors reassess the major theorists in twentieth century anthropology including luminaries such as franz boas claude lévi strauss bronisław malinowski a r radcliffe brown marshall sahlins and lesser known but important anthropological work by berthold lauffer a m hocart kenelm o l burridge and robin ridington among others these essays examine myriad themes such as the pedagogical context of the anthropologist as a teller of stories about indigenous storytellers the colonial context of british anthropological theory and its projects outside the nation state the legacies of claude lévi strauss s structuralism regarding culture specific patterns cognitive universals reflected in empirical examples of kinship myth language classificatory systems and supposed universal mental structures and the career of marshall sahlins and his trajectory from neo evolutionism and structuralism toward an epistemological skepticism of cross cultural miscommunication

this easy reading yet substantive book provides an introduction to sociocultural anthropology across a broad range of cultures including those of today's world its simple and engaging style is designed to spark consideration and discussion the book covers the major issues in the field while emphasizing the relevance of the subject through up to date materials and discussions of events and people in the contemporary world it presents the variety of ways in which humans live and provides wide coverage of the cultures humankind within their appropriate time and space the third edition of a little anthropology has been revised to reflect changes both in anthropology and in the world these revisions include an expanded discussion of tourism and two new summary case studies in the chapter on the developing world among others a vital resource for any reader or professional who is seeking a contemporary cross cultural overview

anthropological literature has traditionally been static and synchronic only occasionally according a role to historical processes but recent years have seen a burgeoning exchange between anthropology and history each field taking on a powerful new dimension in consequence just what this means for anthropologists has not been clear and this collection eight core papers plus introduction and final commentary introduces focus and direction to this interface between anthropology challenges several basic assumptions long held by anthropologists researchers can no longer be satisfied with approaches epitomized in the ethnographic present society may be a bounded entity but culture cannot be treated as such a culture should be examined as it has interacted with other cultures and with its environment over time many traditionalists in anthropology faced with these disturbing new challenges fear the disintegration of the discipline but these thoughtful papers demonstrate on the contrary its vitality growth and promise in this volume major figures in symbolic semiotic anthropology offer various approaches to examining culture through time culture mediated by history and history mediated by culture in its complexity and dynamics the eight core papers focus on particular cultures in various locales hawaii nepal spain japan israel india and indonesia no artificial unity theoretical thematic or epistemological has been imposed the strength of the volume derives from a complementary diversity and tension as each player drawing on a particular culture offers

an original way of penetrating that culture's historical dimensions
