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metaphor theory observes john bird is like mark twain both seem simple upon first introduction now in the most complete study to date of twain s use of figurative language a veteran twain scholar tackles the core of his writing and explores it with theoretical approaches that have rarely been applied to twain providing new insights into how he imagined his world and the singular ways in which he expressed himself from the jumping frog to the late dream narratives bird considers twain s metaphoric construction over his complete career and especially sheds new light on his central texts roughing it the adventures of tom sawyer adventures of huckleberry finn a connecticut yankee in king arthur s court pudd nhead wilson and no 44 the mysterious stranger he reconsiders old times on the mississippi as the most purely metaphorical of twain s writings goes on to look at how twain used metaphor and talked about it in a variety of works and genres and even argues that clemens s pseudonym is not so much an alter ego as a metaphorized

self by offering insight into how twain handled figurative language during the composing process bird reveals not only hidden facets of his artistry but also new aspects of works that we think we know well including some entirely new ideas regarding huck finn that draw on the recent discovery of the first half of the manuscript in addition to dealing with issues currently central to twain studies such as race and gender he also links metaphor to humor and dream theory to further illuminate topics central to his work more than a study of twain s language the book delves into the psychological aspects of metaphor to reveal the writer s attitudes and thoughts showing how using metaphor as a guide to twain reveals much about his composition process applying the insights of metaphor theorists such as roman jakobson and colin m turbayne bird offers readers not only new insights into twain but also an introduction to this interdisciplinary field in lively prose mark twain and metaphor provides a vital way to read twain s entire corpus allowing readers to better appreciate his style humor and obsession with dreams it opens new ground and makes old ground fresh again offering ways to see and resee this essential american writer

in trauma culture and metaphor john wilson and jacob lindy explore the language of both individual and collective trauma in an era dominated by globalization and interconnectedness through lucid careful discussion this important book builds a bridge between the etymology of trauma related terms commonly used in western cultures and those of other cultures such as the burundi rwandan ihahamuka it also provides the clinician with a framework for working with trauma survivors using a cross cultural vocabulary one often based in metaphor to fully address the experienced trauma and to begin work on reconnection and self reinvention

in ursula k le guin consent and metaphor kate sheckler constructs a new method to categorize metaphor arguing that the moment of consent that exists in the form determines the effects of the interchange using the fiction of ursula k le guin with the work of paul ricoeur as a primary theoretical focus sheckler identifies both the dangers and necessity of understanding the interplay that determines by whom and at what point consent is offered within the dynamic shift that occurs in metaphor in doing so she identifies the way marginalized groups and cultures can be reconstructed in service to an outside force and notes the absolute necessity of metaphor as a constructive force in a world where we must imagine new ways to approach the future

with the advent of cognitive linguistics metonymy and metaphor are now recognized as being not only ornamental rhetorical tropes but fundamental figures of thought that shape to a considerable extent the conceptual structure of languages the present volume goes even beyond this insight to propose that grammar itself is metonymical in nature langacker and that conceptual metonymy and metaphor leave their imprints on lexicogrammatical structure

this book traces the image of the pregnant male as it evolves in classical greek literature originating as a representation of paternity and by extension authorship of creative works the image later comes to function also as a means to explore the boundary between the sexes

how is it that one system is more effective appealing satisfying and or more beautiful than another to its stakeholder community this question drove christopher alexander s fifty year quest to explain great physical architecture and gave birth to pattern languages for building that underpin much of modern systems engineering how is it that so many individual stakeholders consistently recognize the same quality the same beauty in a system this question led george lakoff to research the role of conceptual metaphor in human understanding what is essential to stakeholders satisfaction with systems fred brooks in his publications addressed this question this monograph fuses these diverse streams of thought in proposing thriving systems theory by translating alexander s properties of physical design quality into the abstract domain of information systems and modeling metaphor driven modeling incorporates the theory while examining its impact throughout the system life cycle modeling design and deployment the result is holistic and innovative a perspective on system quality invaluable to students practitioners and researchers of software and systems engineering

this book reflects on the ways in which metonymy and metaphor are used conceptually and linguistically to mitigate the more difficult dimensions of death and dying setting out a unique line of research within conceptual metaphor theory the volume argues that metonymic and metaphoric descriptions of death and dying reflect taboos concealment and other considerations not found in figurative descriptions of life producing distinct forms of euphemism frames and mental spaces particular to conceptualizations of death the first part takes a closer look at metonymy to illuminate the ways in which it allows a person to zoom in on death s more inoffensive dimensions or zoom out from its more troubling aspects the second part focuses on the more palatable concepts which metaphorically structure and help to better understand death a wide range of classical and modern examples from european asian australian and african languages and

cultures showcase points of overlap and divergence opening up new lines of inquiry into research on death and dying and offering a linguistically focused complement to anthropological and religious studies on the topic this book will be of interest to scholars in cognitive linguistics sociolinguistics cross cultural communication and cultural studies

in this book victor turner is concerned with various kinds of social actions and how they relate to and come to acquire meaning through metaphors and paradigms in their actors minds how in certain circumstances new forms new metaphors new paradigms are generated to describe and clarify these processes he ranges widely in history and geography from ancient society through the medieval period to modern revolutions and over india africa europe china and meso america two chapters which illustrate religious paradigms and political action explore in detail the confrontation between henry ii and thomas becket and between hidalgo the mexican liberator and his former friends other essays deal with long term religious processes such as the christian pilgrimage in europe and the emergence of anti caste movements in india finally he directs his attention to other social phenomena such as transitional and marginal groups hippies and dissident religious sects showing that in the very process of dying they give rise to new forms of social structure or revitalized versions of the old order
