the german invasion of poland in 1939 gave the nazis the opportunity to implement their master plan to eliminate europe s jews part of the plan encompassed confining the jews in a restricted area of warsaw to make their survival difficult followed by mass transportation of survivors to concentration camps where they were killed the jews in the warsaw ghetto did not go quietly to their deaths but engaged in armed resistance this riveting volume describes the ghetto s daily life the people s extraordinary efforts to survive under horrendous circumstances and the events that led to the uprising and the ghetto s 1943 destruction

in 1943 against utterly hopeless odds the jews of the warsaw ghetto rose up to defy the nazi horror machine that had set out to exterminate them one of the leaders of the jewish fighting organization which led the uprisings was yitzhak zuckerman known by his underground pseudonym antek decades later living in israel antek dictated his memoirs the hebrew publication of those seven years 1939 1946 was a major event in the historiography of the holocaust and now antek s memoirs are available in english unlike holocaust books that focus on the annihilation of european jews antek s account is of the daily struggle to maintain human dignity under the most dreadful conditions his passionate involved testimony which combines detail authenticity and gripping immediacy has unique historical importance the memoirs situate the ghetto and the resistance in the social and political context that preceded them when prewar zionist and socialist youth movements were gradually forged into what became the first significant armed resistance against the nazis in all of occupied europe antek also describes the activities of the resistance after the destruction of the ghetto when 20 000 jews hid in aryan warsaw and then participated in illegal immigration to palestine after the war the only extensive document by any jewish resistance leader in europe antek s book is central to understanding ghetto life and underground activities jewish resistance under the nazis and polish jewish relations during and after the war this extraordinary work is a fitting monument to the heroism of a people in 1943 against utterly hopeless odds the jews of the warsaw ghetto rose up to defy the nazi horror machine that had set out to exterminate them one of the leaders of the jewish fighting organization which led the uprisings was yitzhak zuckerman kno

the warsaw ghetto uprising was planned and accomplished by two organizations the zob zydowska organizacja bojowa jewish fighting organization and the zzw zydowska zwiazek wojskowy jewish military union while the part of the zob is well known though multiple books and articles the part of the zzw has been largely ignored for political reasons using extensive primary source material from polish jewish and german sources much of it here translated into english for the first time the role of the zzw is reported and analyzed with special attention given to the fierce battle waged over the polish and jewish flags hoisted over the ghetto

describes life in the section of warsaw where polish jews were confined by the nazis in the early 1940s focusing on the final days of fighting prior to the destruction of the ghetto in 1943

the warsaw ghetto uprising was a battle the jews could not hope to win against the more powerful nazis but they decided not to go quietly to certain death when germany invaded poland in 1939 beginning world war ii the nazis quickly destroyed jewish life after stripping jews of all their rights the nazis forced them into a ghetto surrounded by brick walls after more than three years of starvation disease and death the jewish people decided to resist when the nazis came to annihilate the ghetto the jewish fighters were ready to strike back author linda jacobs altman chronicles this brave and heroic story from the holocaust

jews in nazi occupied warsaw during the 1940s were under increasing threat as they were stripped of their rights and forced to live in a guarded ghetto away from the non jewish polish population within the ghettos a small but distinct group existed the assimilated acculturated and baptized jews unwilling to integrate into the jewish community and unable to merge with the polish one they formed a group of their own remaining in a state of suspension throughout the interwar period in 1940 with the closure of the jewish residential quarter in warsaw their identity was chosen for them person looks at what it meant for assimilated jews to leave their prewar neighborhoods understood as both a physical environment and a mixed polish jewish cultural community and to enter a new jewish neighborhood she reveals the diversity of this group and how its members identity shaped their involvement in and contribution to ghetto life in the first english language study of this small but influential group person illuminates the important role of the acculturated and assimilated jews in the history and memory of the warsaw ghetto

his name is yossel in another time in another place this fifteen year old boy could have grown to be a great artist but in nazi occupied poland yossel a jew is an untermensch and thus has no rights and no future when the nazis confiscate his family s home and force them to live in the overcrowded tenements of the warsaw ghetto it appears that yossel s artistic gift will be shattered instead the awful suffering of his family the terrible conditions of the ghetto and the increasingly barbaric treatment inspire him yossel april 19 1943 is this boy s story told through his sketches it is a compelling account of increasing horror depicted by an artist whose soul drives him to bear witness through his art
