owners in a southern family in dispersal and decline in 1698 a planter named elias ball arrived in south carolina from devon england to claim an inheritance to one half of a plantation by 1865 the ball family of south carolina owned over a dozen plantations along the cooper river near charleston the crop was carolina gold rice the empire was grown with seeds from madagascar and slave labour purchased on the charleston docks by the time the civil war ended nearly 4 000 people had been enslaved by the balls descendents of the ball slaves may number as high as 11 000 today
