traces and in requirements engineering as for example use case maps or life sequence charts these techniques are used to capture requirements to capture use cases in system documentation to specify test cases or to visualize runs of existing systems they are often employed to represent concurrent systems that interact via message passing or method invocation in telecommunications for more than 15 years the international telecommunication union has standardized the message sequence charts mscs notation in its recommendation z 120 more recently with the emergence of uml as a predominant software design methodology there has been special interest in the development of the sequence diagram notation as a result the most recent version 2.0 of uml encompasses the message sequence chart notation including its hierarchical modeling features other scenario favored diagrams in uml 2.0 include activity diagrams and timing diagrams
