demand for a publication which explores the potential impact of a new education approach and issues with preparation teaching and learning for nurses and the breadth and dimensions of teaching and learning nmc proposed roles of practice supervisor practice assessor and academic assessor will not have a prescribed preparation programme and universities and practice partners will be seeking guidance and direction in developing local programmes of preparation
