popular culture poe yields more global influence than any other u s author this influence however cannot be attributed solely to the quality of poe s texts or to his compellingly tragic biography rather his continued prominence as a writer owes much to the ways that poe has been interpreted portrayed and packaged by an extensive group of mediators ranging from anthologizers editors translators and fellow writers to literary critics filmmakers musicians and illustrators in this volume the work of presenting poe s texts for public consumption becomes a fascinating object of study in its own right one that highlights the powerful and often overlooked influence of those who have edited anthologized translated and adapted the author s writing over the past 170 years

while kierkegaard is primarily known as a philosopher or religious thinker his writings have also been used extensively by literary writers critics and artists this use can be traced in the work of major cultural figures not just in denmark and scandinavia but also in the wider world they have been attracted to his creative mixing of genres his complex use of pseudonyms his rhetoric and literary style and his rich images parables and allegories the present volume documents this influence in the different language groups and traditions tome v treats the work of a heterogeneous group of writers from the romance languages and from central and eastern europe kierkegaard has been particularly important for spanish literature the argentine writers jorge luis borges leonardo castellani and ernesto sábato the mexican writer carlos fuentes and the spanish essayist and philosopher maría zambrano were all inspired to varying degrees by him the dane also appears in the work of romanian writer max blecher while the portuguese author fernando pessoa was almost certainly inspired by kierkegaard s use of pseudonyms kierkegaard has also influenced diverse literary figures from central and eastern europe his influence appears in the novels of the contemporary hungarian authors péter nadas and péter esterházy the work of the russian writer and literary critic mikhail bakhtin the polish writer witold gombrowicz and the czech novelist ivan klíma tome v also examines how kierkegaard s treatment of the story of abraham and isaac in fear and trembling interested the polish born israeli novelist pinhas sadeh

in search of the sacred book studies the artistic incorporation of religious concepts such as prophecy eternity and the afterlife in the contemporary latin american novel it departs from sociopolitical readings by noting the continued relevance of religion in latin american life and culture despite modernity s powerful secularizing influence analyzing jorge luis borges s secularized narrative theology in his essays and short stories the book follows the development of the latin american novel from the early twentieth century until today by examining the attempts of major novelists from maría luisa bombal alejo carpentier and juan rulfo to julio cortázar gabriel garcía márquez and josé lezama lima to

sacralize the novel by incorporating traits present in the sacred texts of many religions it concludes with a view of the desacralization of the novel by more recent authors from elena poniatowska and fernando vallejo to roberto bolaño

it is well known that jorge luis borges was a translator but this has been considered a curious minor aspect of his literary achievement few have been aware of the number of texts he translated the importance he attached to this activity or the extent to which the translated works inform his own stories and poems between the age of ten when he translated oscar wilde and the end of his life when he prepared a spanish version of the prose edda borges transformed the work of poe kafka hesse kipling melville gide faulkner whitman woolf chesterton and many others in a multitude of essays lectures and interviews borges analyzed the versions of others and developed an engaging view about translation he held that a translation can improve an original that contradictory renderings of the same work can be equally valid and that an original can be unfaithful to a translation borges s bold habits as translator and his views on translation had a decisive impact on his creative process translation is also a recurrent motif in borges s stories in the immortal for example a character who has lived for many centuries regains knowledge of poems he had authored and almost forgotten by way of modern translations many of borges s fictions include actual or imagined translations and some of his most important characters are translators in pierre menard author of the quixote borges s character is a respected

symbolist poet but also a translator and the narrator insists that menard s masterpiece his invisible work adds unsuspected layers of meaning to cervantes s don quixote george steiner cites this short story as the most acute most concentrated commentary anyone has offered on the business of translation in an age where many discussions of translation revolve around the dichotomy faithful unfaithful this book will surprise and delight even borges s closest readers and critics

includes entries for maps and atlases
