what they did to the kid is a memoir spinning as a comic novel for general fiction readers intrigued by boys school tales and baby boomers who survived catholic school ryan o hara coming of age from 14 to 24 is the wise adolescent narrating readers entry into the secret culture of 1950 s altar boys who go to the seminary meet priests and must decide their own identities the novel s interior ticking covers the clock and calendar of boys emerging consciences and edgy consciousness the san francisco chronicle says jack fritscher reads gloriously strong characters and snappy dialog propel the character driven plot of male dominant pecking order at misericordia seminary aptly nicknamed misery ryan o hara exposes his own story he s trapped for oxygen with 500 other boys by the
