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mystics are path breaking religious practitioners who claim to have experience the infinite word defying mystery that is god many have been gifted writers with an uncanny ability to communicate the great realities of life with both a theologian's precision and a poet's lyricism they use words to jolt us into recognizing ineffable mysteries surging beneath the surface of our lives and within the depths of our hearts and by their artistry can awaken us to see and savor fugitive glimpses of a god drenched world in mystics william harmless s j introduces readers to the scholarly study of mysticism he explores both mystics extraordinary lives and their no less extraordinary writings using a unique case study method centered on detailed examinations of six major christian mystics thomas merton bernard of clairvaux hildegard of bingen bonaventure meister eckhart and evagrius ponticus rather than presenting mysticism as a subtle web of psychological or theological abstractions harmless s case study approach brings things down to earth restoring mystics to their historical context harmless highlights the pungent diversity of mystical experiences and mystical theologies stepping beyond christianity he also explores mystical elements within islam and buddhism offering a chapter on the popular sufi poet rumi and one on the famous japanese zen master dogen harmless concludes with an overview of the century long scholarly conversation on mysticism and offers a unique multifaceted optic for understanding mystics their communities and their writings geared toward a wide audience mystics balances state of the art scholarship with accessible lucid prose

in september of 1976 a group of some fifty scholars and practising mystics gathered at the university of calgary the chief objective of the conference was to ponder and assess the nature of mysticism in

its eastern western and north american indian forms the method the conference followed was somewhat unusual in that it aimed at a dialogue between the practising mystics and the scholars what this book presents to the reader is not the outcome of the dialogue but the personal statements and papers from which the dialogue began of course there is a degree to which the dialogue is already present in that the papers of the scholars were written with the statements of the mystics in hand among some of the philosophers present a set of more formal comments on each others presentations was recorded and these have been included

remaining a classic in its field this book explains first how mysticism relates to such things as vitalism theology psychology symbolism and magic this treatment may seem unusual for christian mysticism but it relates widely to the world as we know it and the different practices therein part two explores the awakening purification and illumination of yourself and gives solid groundwork for such things as voices visions dreams and other mystical experience

and the only family he has ever known ripped from his grasp thayliss must try to stop lakos from his plot to control all mystic orders and assume the throne of the voduss grei

mysticism is an ancient practice that incorporates meditation contemplation worship philosophy the quest for enlightenment the thirst for a better world and the experience of divine presence

offering different essays of the practice of mysticism underhill gives a thorough treatment of the practice that relies on experience rather than logic to justify the matters of faith while a dangerous path to follow as it can quickly lead to paths away from god this thinking is valid to a point in that we must be able to experience the fullness of god in some way to be fully alive in the realization of who god the father is

the culmination of de certeau s lifelong engagement with the human sciences this volume is both an analysis of christian mysticism during the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries and an application of this influential scholar s transdisciplinary historiography

in his classic exposition of theology of the church lossky states that the eastern tradition has never made a sharp distinction between mysticism and theology between personal experience of the divine mysteries and the dogma of the church

first published in 1999 this is volume iii of six of a series on the psychology of religion written around 1925 this book is a psychological study of human nature it includes a philosophical chapter and also one in which are set forth the practical consequences to religion of some of its conclusions but whatever may be the importance of these two chapters the book is to be judged primarily as a psychological study of aspects of human nature conspicuous in mystical religion
