in two marriages from paradise to hell and back again jette tells the story of her journey through love and heartbreak the first third of the book is written from the perspective of a narrator and details jette s career social life and the betrayal by her first husband the last two thirds written by jette in the first person is a tribute to her second husband ernest edward john paradine a former major of the british royal artillery who was honored by the queen in 1981 with an mbe jette recounts the couple s move to england and her experiences travelling with ernest to india pakistan brunei singapore and jordan along the way the reader learns of ernest s family secrets and jette s love for england and classical music the book is a true love story and a glimpse into life in third world countries from 1988 to 2000 with unbelievable coincidences playing a role in both jette and ernest s lives

through her visions and dreams the story takes the reader to paris france washington dc chicago virginia and florida for the reader of the durabone prophecies author frederick douglas harper evokes intense emotional feelings laughter sensual arousal nostalgic memories intellectual debate philosophical questions and spiritual exploration the durabone prophecies is a self help novel because psychological principles and messages are embedded in the story also characters are subliminal teachers and role models of human imperfection and vulnerability as well as human possibility and hope

a christmas themed collection of ghost stories may seem like an odd idea but english writer jerome k jerome pulls it off in the engaging volume told after supper pull it out at your next holiday gathering or read it any time you re craving some spine tingling short fiction

church beyond walls tells inspiring informative and occasionally funny stories of how a group of people took christian spirituality outside of church buildings to engage a world increasingly uninterested in religion god and faith from imaginative and wide ranging experiments it draws out principles to inspire local churches to express their faith in their communities and it shares liturgical and other resources developed for these occasions based in brighton and known as beyond for over ten years this group of dreamers artists and provocateurs have experimented with public art created light shows and walking meditations partnered with retailers to create spiritual shop window trails celebrated the festivals of the church in secular spaces used folk traditions and more to introduce people to the christian faith their goal and the aim of this book is to help local churches create opportunities for epiphanies moments when the divine can break into human experience

sandy s picture stories is designed for busy teachers of beginner esl each unit is based on a topic useful for new immigrants like the noisy neighbor or the burglar every unit begins with a series of pictures meant to be copies on to light card stock and cut into card sets this is followed by a randomized card set of key words and another of sentences students are meant to sequence the pictures and invent the story then match key words to pictures and revise their story more advanced students can match the pictures with the sentence cards and to read the story to a partners this if followed by a correct sentence sequence so students can read it silently and orally and adjust their picture stories if needed next we have a word scramble to reinforce

vocabulary learning and scrambled sentences to build grammar and syntax awareness the unit concludes with a listening exercise to further reinforce learning the total two hour lesson is quick and easy to prepare yet is engaging and involving so students participate eagerly this is a handy book that all teachers of beginner esl will want to have
