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this book examines the political perspective of french thinker and historian jacques ranci ère ranci ère argues that

a democratic politics emerges out of people's acting under the presupposition of their own equality with those better situated in the social hierarchy todd may examines and extends this presupposition offering a normative framework for understanding it placing it in the current political context and showing how it challenges traditional political philosophy and opens up neglected political paths he demonstrates that the presupposition of equality orients political action around those who act on their own behalf and those who act in solidarity with them rather than as with the political theories of john rawls robert nozick and amartya sen those who distribute the social goods as may argues ranci re's view offers both hope and perspective for those who seek to think about and engage in progressive political action

explores how elites restrict access to public beaches around the globe beaches are a beloved form of public space yet there has been an alarming global trend of restricting access to public sections of beaches to ensure that waterfront property owners can enjoy the shoreline exclusively or develop the land for commercial use beach politics examines how over the past forty years privatization of public space has accelerated with the help of both local governments and national corporations on a local level this can entail a group of wealthy neighbors purposely blocking off public beach access in their neighborhood hiring security guards building fences or putting up no trespassing signs to turn away members of the public who have every right to be there on a state or national level it can manifest as gated communities owned by private corporations sectioning off huge swaths of land limiting access or governments promoting private rather than public development along the shoreline whenever disputes about land use arise the powers that be often side with private interests and the wealthy over those with fewer resources and frequently people of color with the continuing threat of climate change decisions about how and where to harden or protect the shoreline often limits public use focused on beaches access to public space and social justice this book brings together powerful contributions illustrating how these issues are inextricably bound with socioeconomic status racial segregation and climate justice together they highlight how through illegal actions and exclusionary legislation the beach can be transformed from a strip of nature into a palimpsest of greed racism ecological disregard and socioeconomic discrimination

in this book todd may shows how democratic progressive politics can happen and how it is happening in very different arenas he takes an intensive look at a range of contemporary political movements and shows how to one degree or another they exemplify the political thought of jacques ranc re may's easy clear writing style means that no philosophical background is required following an essential overview of ranc re's thought he

considers the following groups the algerian refugee movement in montreal for citizenship the first palestinian intifada the politics of equality and identity politics in relation to the zapatista movement a local food co op in south carolina and an anarchist press in oakland essentially this book shows how political theory and practice can enlighten one another and in an age of cynicism fear and despair todd may suggests there is hope for the possibility of progressive democratic action it will appeal to rancia re students scholars and political activists alike

the value of democracy is taken for granted today even by those interested in criticizing the fundamental structures of society things would be better the argument goes if only things were more democratic the word democracy means the power of the people and scholars with a critical and progressive outlook often invoke this meaning as a way of justifying the honorific status accorded to the term the power of the people to resist racism sexism imperialism climate change etc but if the people have the power to resist these structures of domination and inequality they also have the power to reinforce them by treating democracy as an end in itself political theorists of a critical bent overwhelmingly assume that the demos if given the opportunity will advance progressive or even radical politics but given the recent successes of right wing populism and the persistence of pathological views such as climate skepticism is this assumption still warranted if not then can democracy really save us

disaffected parties reveals how alienation from politics effected crucial changes to the shape and status of literary form recovering the earliest expressions of grumbling irritability and cynicism towards politics this study asks how unsettled partisan legacies converged with more recent discontents to forge a seminal period in the making of english literature and thereby poses wide ranging questions about the lines between politics and aesthetics reading works including laurence Sterne s tristram shandy James Boswell s life of Johnson the novels of Maria Edgeworth and Jane Austen and the satirical poetry of Lord Byron in tandem with print culture and partisan activity this book shows how these writings remained animated by disaffected impulses and recalcitrant energies at odds with available party positions and emerging governmental norms even as they sought to imagine perspectives that looked beyond the divided political world altogether no one can be more sick of or indifferent to politics than I am Lord Byron wrote in 1820 between the later eighteenth century and the romantic age disaffected political attitudes acquired increasingly familiar shapes yet this was also a period of ferment in which unrest associated with the global age of revolutions including a dynamic transatlantic opposition movement collided with often inchoate assemblages of parties and constituencies as writers adopted increasingly emphatic removes from the

political arena and cultivated familiar stances of cynicism detachment and retreat their estrangement also promised to loop back into political engagement and to make their works parties all their own

peter shore worked under hugh gaitskell serving in successive labour cabinets under first harold wilson and subsequently james callaghan he wrote the 1964 1966 and 1970 general election manifestos for the party and stood in both the 1980 and the 1983 party leadership elections he would go on to be known as one of the labour party s most important thinkers he had a long political career at the upper levels of the labour party and was close to successive leaders despite this he was also independent minded as evidenced by the 1976 imf crisis and his long standing opposition to european integration as well as this key debate the authors also address crucial issues within the labour movement from macroeconomic management to the extent to which the party can be a force for socialism this remarkable new study offers a comprehensive and timely reappraisal of the man and his record examining the context within which he operated his approach and responses to changing social and economic norms his opposition to britain s membership of what is now the eu and how he was viewed by peers from across the political spectrum finally it examines the overall impact of peter shore on the development of

misunderstood journey we gain a unique broader perspective on early peacemaking efforts in israel palestine the american jewish role in the history of the state binationalism as political theology an american view of binationalism and the charged realities of israel today

in the jersey shore dominick mazzagetti provides a modern re telling of the history culture and landscapes of this famous region from the 1600s to the present the shore from sandy hook to cape may became a national resort in the late 1800s and contributes enormously to new jersey s economy today the devastation of hurricane sandy in 2012 underscored the area s central place in the state s identity and the rebuilding efforts after the storm restored its economic health divided into chronological and thematic sections this book will attract general readers interested in the history of the shore how it appeared to early european explorers how the earliest settlers came to the beaches for the whaling trade the first attractions for tourists in the nineteenth century and how the coming of railroads and ultimately automobiles transformed the shore into a major vacation destination over a century later mazzagetti also explores how the impact of changing national mores on development race relations and the environment impacted the shore in recent decades and will into the future ultimately this book is an enthusiastic and comprehensive portrait by a native son whose passion for the region is shared by millions of beachgoers throughout the northeast
