if you who read this can say i am not under fire i am not under torture i am not on the run if i hear a noise at six in
the morning i know it is a neighbour or a milkman not the secret police no one in my country is arrested and held
without prompt charge and trial then you owe it in a larger degree than most historians have so far allowed to the
