in the year 1983 the British Trust for Ornithology celebrated its first 50 years this volume records much of the history of birdwatching and ornithology since the early 1930s the book is not a history of the BTO but many of the trust's achievements helped fashion the development and direction of ornithology over the decades and major aspects of the trust's work rightly have detailed treatment the book ranges widely it looks at the changing bird as well as the changing bird watcher and records the work of related conservation bodies it considers the future and the past and includes an extensive section of useful facts and figures whilst never losing sight of the central theme which is the book's title

Frank Farley 1870-1949 was a passionate naturalist and enthusiastic booster for rural development in western Canada he supported and managed newly designated migratory bird sanctuaries networked with expert ornithologists across the continent mentored young people including famous Canadian writer and grand nephew Farley Mowat and published widely to scientific

and popular audiences his most significant publication was *Birds of the Battle River Region* his data and research served as the basis for the first account of the birds of Alberta published in 1958 Farley's career shows how a single individual can make significant contributions to the fields of ornithology and environmental conservation both locally and internationally *Frank Farley and the Birds of Alberta* adds a new layer to a complex western Canadian past and will be an invaluable resource for those interested in Canadian environmental history climate change and ecological activism

The book describes all the main habitat types the structure and composition of bird communities and reviews bird sites and their distribution throughout Britain Rob Fuller's book would not have been possible but for the nationwide cooperative endeavour by amateur and professional ornithologists naturalists and conservationists which led to the British Trust for Ornithology's Register of Ornithological Sites sponsored by the Nature Conservancy Council hitherto few books have dealt primarily with bird habitats but the subject is of urgent importance now that exploitation of the environment has left few corners of Britain untouched or unthreatened even so the book is much more than timely it also extends the reader's interest to an area of bird study that has perhaps been too little considered the text is supported by more than 100 diagrams and maps and over 50 photographs in addition there are 53 superbly evocative drawings by Donald Watson for the birdwatcher and all involved with conservation this is stimulating reading and an essential reference

winner of the 2017 John Thackray Medal awarded by the Society for the History of Natural History U.K. Martin Lister 1639–1712 was a consummate virtuoso the first arachnologist and conchologist and a royal physician as one of the most prominent corresponding fellows of the Royal Society many of Lister's discoveries in natural history archaeology medicine and chemistry were printed in the *Philosophical Transactions* Lister corresponded extensively with explorers and other virtuosi such as John Ray who provided him with specimens observations and locality records from Jamaica America Barbados France Italy the Netherlands and his native England this volume of ca. 400 letters one of three consists of Lister's correspondence dated from 1662 to 1677 including his time as a Cambridge fellow his medical training in Montpellier and his years as a practicing physician in York

Estuaries are rightly of great interest and concern to the birdwatcher most teem with thousands of waders geese ducks gulls

and other species that use them at times throughout the year they are also among the last of the wild places left in Britain and Europe. The Birds of Estuaries Enquiry, sponsored by the Nature Conservancy Council and organised by the BTO, RSPB and the Wildfowl Trust, spanned six years and Tony Prater's report now provides a detailed insight into the birds which use and in many cases depend on this special habitat of great interest to birdwatchers. The book also will be essential reading for professional conservationists and all involved in the planning and use of estuaries. It assesses the importance of each estuary and the distribution and numbers of all species generally present and by setting this in an international framework demonstrates the remarkable importance of the estuaries. Around these islands threats to the fabric of the landscape and its wildlife abound and estuaries are not exempt from barrage schemes, industrial and agricultural reclamations and many other pressures exist and are the subject of chapters which survey the situation now and in the future. The text is graced by John Busby's accomplished and evocative drawings and there are numerous maps and diagrams as well as photographs of typical estuaries. Jacket illustration by John Busby.

The atlas plots the results of the survey organised by the BTO and the IWC during the years 1968-72. Over 250 maps show the distribution of 218 species. This companion volume to the atlas of wintering birds in Britain and Ireland is derived from yearly surveys of breeding birds in Britain and Ireland during 1968-72, organised by the British Trust for Ornithology and the Irish Wildbird Conservancy. Each of the 3 862 10 km squares of Britain and Ireland was visited during the five years and the resulting records over 285 000 are summarised in the maps. The full-page maps plot the known distribution of all but 11 of the 229 breeding species located during the survey period. Each map has an accompanying text which describes the species, habitat, the problems involved in proving breeding, the historical background to the species range and any changes in its numbers. The probable reasons for these changes are discussed and an attempt made to assess the total number of birds for each species. Jacket design by Robert Gillmor.

This companion volume to the atlas of breeding birds of Britain and Ireland is derived from surveys of birds present in Britain and Ireland during the three winters 1981-82, 1982-83 and 1983-84. The surveys were organised by the British Trust for Ornithology and the Irish Wildbird Conservancy as were the earlier breeding birds surveys. The winter atlas maps 200 species. 192

of which have full page two colour maps faced by a page of text the texts written by over 100 specialists comment on the survey results the species generally and the distribution and abundance as mapped in addition there are introductory chapters on the maps the weather in the three winters bird patterns and movements and appendices describing the planning organisation field methods and processing of the survey data from record cards to computer output and maps a team of 23 artists led by robert gillmor has provided the line drawings which head the species accounts
