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max hasting's exceptional kirkus reviews starred review account of the famous world war ii d day landings will stand with that of the best journalists and writers who witnessed it the new york times book review on june 6 1944 the american and british armies staged the greatest amphibious landing in history called operation overlord the battle for the liberation of europe despite the allies' absolute command of sea and air and vast firepower it took ten weeks of fierce fighting for them to overpower the tenacious superbly skilled german army forty years later british war correspondent and military historian max hasting's shares a dense dramatic portrait of the normandy invasion that overturns the traditional legends first published in 1984 overlord will shock those who regard the invasion of normandy and the subsequent battles as triumphs of american british and canadian military heroism the new york times instead hasting's provides a brilliant controversial perspective on the devastating battles based on the eyewitness accounts of survivors from both sides plus a wealth of previously untapped sources and documents a masterly book rich in insight shrewd and weighty in judgement max hasting's stands in the first rank of writers on modern war financial times

a fresh and incisive examination of one of the second world war's crucial campaigns the battle for normandy in the months after d day what happened to the allied armies in normandy in the months after d day 1944 why after the initial success of the landings did their advance stall a few miles inland from the beaches why did the british take so long to capture caen why did the us infantry struggle so much in the bocage south of omaha beach who was right about the conduct of the land campaign eisenhower or montgomery how did the germans deprived of air support manage to hold off such a massive allied force for more than two months and if enigma was allowing the allies to read german battleplans why did things go wrong as often as they did the battle of normandy re-examines the demands and difficulties of the campaign and sheds new light on both with the aid of accounts from veterans on both sides oral history forms a large part of the book it also analyses in detail the plans and performance of the commanders involved eisenhower bradley patton montgomery crerar and of course rommel controversial and at times catastrophic the battle of normandy was the last great set piece battle in history and is long overdue for reassessment

6 june 1944 the date that marked the beginning of the end of the war in north west europe and the day on which the liberation of france began this lavishly illustrated book relives the story of d day from the pre-invasion preparations through to the landings

themselves and the subsequent battle for control of normandy all beautifully illustrated through an unparalleled collection of paintings drawings and maps however it is not simply a collection of artwork first and foremost it is a historically accurate recollection of events painstakingly researched with the assistance of leading historians being illustrated by the world's leading military and aviation artists rather than photographs makes it a totally unique account and very different to any others much of the work included was produced exclusively for the book and many specially created maps and diagrams make the edition perfect for military enthusiasts and art collectors alike these exceptional works help knit together this brief account of d day serving as a lasting tribute to all who fought during the epic normandy campaign

this enhanced ebook contains scores of fascinating additional material including astonishing black white and colour footage taken at the time of the events video introduction by antony beevor 26 embedded film clips including footage of the normandy landings firefights in the deadly bocage hedgerows allied bombing raids allied commanders the liberation of paris rarely seen original nbc and universal newsreels and radio broadcasts announcing the invasion rare colour footage shot by the journalist jack lieb the normandy landings that took place on d day involved by far the largest invasion fleet ever known the scale of the undertaking was simply awesome what followed them was some of the most cunning ferocious and savage fighting of the war as casualties mounted so too did tensions between the commanders on both sides meanwhile french civilians caught in the middle of the fighting endured terrible suffering even the joys of liberation had their dark side the war in northern france marked the whole of the post war world profoundly influencing relations between europe and america making use of overlooked and new material from more than 30 archives in 6 countries d day is the most vivid and well researched account yet of the battle of normandy as with stalingrad and berlin antony beevor's gripping narrative conveys the true experience of war

includes over 12 photos and maps of the overlord operations operation overlord the normandy invasion like william the conqueror s before it or the inchon landing afterwards will long be studied as a classic in military planning logistics and operations overlord depended to a remarkable degree upon the use of air power in virtually all its forms a half century ago aircraft were primitive vehicles of war compared to the modern attackers of the gulf war era with their precision weapons advanced navigational sensor systems and communications yet the airplane still had a profound impact upon the success of the invasion simply stated without air power normandy would have been impossible

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
