cities have consistently enforced their ordinances after passage in other communities
implementation is weak or nonexistent and thousands of workers do not benefit from laws
designed to ensure that they are paid a living wage Luce provides in *Fighting for a Living Wage*
the first serious examination of the reasons for implementation failure as well as an analysis
of the factors that lead to success Luce argues that citizens can play a significant role in

implementing and monitoring living wage policies even where governments oppose the movement or are reluctant to enforce the laws in question. Luce finds that the nature of the campaign to formulate and pass policy can influence the likelihood of successful implementation. wage level specifically the minimum wage has a greater negative impact on employment in low wage firms than in high wage firms our results are robust for different treatment groups sample attrition correction and placebo tests
