and had held similar positions with other orchestras including the boston symphony cleveland orchestra and kansas city conservatory depaul university northwestern university and roosevelt university in chicago the art of french horn playing set the pattern and other books in the series soon followed offering help to students in learning to master their instruments and achieve their goals
