with flyers highlights and lowlights from wonderful and wacky memories to the famous and infamous such moments include the era of the broad street bullies as well as the playoff drought in the late 1980s and early 1990s learn how visionary founding owner ed snider created the flyers and sold the city of philadelphia on the sport of hockey get the inside story of how the franchise built a championship squad then repeatedly rebuilt it over the next three decades to stay at the top of the nhl in the process compiling the league s second best all time winning percentage enjoy classic tales about the great rivalries especially with the rangers devils and penguins about the great coaches including fred shero and pat quinn and countless great players barber clarke parent poulin hextall primeau and many more whether providing fond memories goose bumps or laughs this portrait of the team and its history is sure to appeal to the fan who has been through it all this updated edition takes readers through the 2012 13 season and features the flyers trip to the 2010 stanley cup finals as well as recent stars claude giroux scott hartnell kimmo timonen and more

this work is a game by game account of the philadelphia athletics pitiful 1916 season in which they won just 36 of 154 games it starts with a brief biography of the team s living symbol a s manager and co owner connie mack and moves through the birth of the

franchise and into its first era of glory in which the a s won world championships in 1910 1911 and 1913 following the a s stunning defeat in the 1914 world series to the underdog boston braves mack dismantled his championship club and finished last in the american league for seven straight seasons the 1916 campaign was the nadir the team s few solid veterans had a supporting cast of underachievers college boys raw rookies no hopers and sub par pitching the book chronicles the daily grind of a team that had no chance to begin with and quickly became the laughingstock of the al many humorous anecdotes needless to say

on friday october 7 1977 the philadelphia phillies experienced some of the highest highs and lowest lows in their then 94 year history all within the span of a single grey afternoon an afternoon that turned so dark so fast that phils fans would refer to it forever after as black friday following a 1976 season in which the perennial laughingstock of a franchise won 101 games the 77 phillies had been even better with a lineup that featured mike schmidt and greg luzinski in their primes a rotation anchored by steve carlton and perhaps the deepest bench and bullpen in baseball history these phillies took a back seat to nobody so when they faced los angeles in the nlcs few thought the dodgers stood much of a chance after splitting the first two games of the five game series in la the clubs arrived at veterans stadium that afternoon with phillies fans anticipating a coronation and after jeering a jittery burt hooton off the mound and watching their phils take a 5 3 lead into the ninth everything was going according to plan until it wasn t within ten minutes everything had spectacularly imploded even now four decades later phillies fans debate just how and why it all went so wrong so suddenly the ten minute collapse black friday and the fall of the 1977 phillies transports you back to that october afternoon and parks you behind the plate at the vet where you can experience it all as if you were there for every exhilarating exasperating moment

this violent empire traces the origins of american violence racism and paranoia to the founding moments of the new nation and the initial instability of americans national sense of self fusing cultural and political analyses to create a new form of political history carroll smith rosenberg explores the ways the founding generation lacking a common history governmental infrastructures and shared culture solidified their national sense of self by imagining a series of others african americans native americans women the propertyless whose differences from european american male founders overshadowed the differences that divided those founders these others dangerous and polluting had to be excluded from the european american body politic feared but also desired they refused to be marginalized incurring increasingly enraged enactments of their political and social exclusion that shaped our long history of racism xenophobia and sexism close readings of political rhetoric during the constitutional debates reveal the genesis of this long history

the émigré merchant stephen girard of philadelphia 1750 1831 embodied many of the values associated with the revolutionary american republic he chose to call home after haphazardly arriving in philadelphia in 1776 the frenchman benefited mightily from the economic opportunities of his volatile era as he entered maturity the merchant banker found meaning through civic leadership and his famous last will and testament in which he codified his approach to national progress through civic works studying girard's philosophy of engaged citizenship illuminates the cultural forces at work in the early united states girard also bequeathed to posterity an enormous cache of archival records a substantial library a diverse collection of fine and decorative art as well as an intriguing assemblage of material culture related to the careers of his philosopher ships named for his favored authors this collection creates a rare opportunity to conjure the world inhabited by girard and his intimates including his wife mary lum girard his enslaved woman hannah female relations of mixed racial backgrounds unmarried intimate partners and business associates making use of this remarkable and underexplored collection allows girard's story to transcend an individual's life shedding light on economy society civic culture labor family relationships and global politics at a pivotal moment in history portrait of a citizen is the first

modern scholarly study to link the material relics of girard s life to the history of his heavily litigated will culminating in the u s civil rights movement of the 1960s by viewing girard s life works and memory across the centuries the book poses persistent and pressing questions about civic belonging in the united states

freedom s prophet is a biography of richard allen founder of the first major african american church and leading black activist of america s early nation gold winner of the foreword magazine book of the year award biography category a tireless minister abolitionist and reformer richard allen inaugurated some of the most important institutions in african american history influencing nearly every black leader of the nineteenth century from frederick douglass to w e b du bois born a slave in colonial philadelphia allen secured his freedom during the american revolution becoming one of the nation s leading black activists before the civil war among his achievements allen helped form the african methodist episcopal ame church co authored the first copyrighted pamphlet by an african american writer published the first african american eulogy of george washington and convened the first national convention of black reformers in a time when most black men and women were categorized as slave property allen was championed as a black hero in freedom s prophet history professor richard s newman describes allen s continually evolving life and thought setting both in the context of his times from allen s antislavery struggles and belief in interracial harmony to his reflections on black democracy and black emigration newman traces allen s impact on american reform and reformers on racial attitudes of the early republic and on the black struggle for justice in the age of adams jefferson madison and washington whether serving as america s first black bishop challenging slave holding statesmen in a nation devoted to liberty or visiting the president s house the first black activist to do so allen s achievements place him in the pantheon of americas great founding figures

all over the world the statues of mary are miraculously crying in the meantime a journalist in washington d c is diverted away from her own personal demons when she takes it upon herself to question why the vatican is not declaring these occurrences as miracles after witnessing the unexplainable phenomena herself the journalist suspects her nightly barage of haunting nightmares about the violent murders of countless women from five thousand year old priestesses to women accused of being witches in the seventeenth century may have something to do with the answer as she investigates the biggest story of her life

women all over the world in the 21st century are feeling the awakening as the discovery of ancient artifacts are disproving the beliefs set forth by patriarchal religions for thousands of years when the journalist receives a visitation from a beautiful goddess who at first appears to be the virgin mary she suddenly realizes that an ancient religious and political cover up has grossly distorted some very important historical truths as the journalist investigates and begins to publicly write about what she has uncovered death threats and terror follow next as powerful members of the world s patriarchal religions and the age old male run organizations that support them fight viciously to keep one of the world s oldest and most deceptive societal form of control against women hidden from the world but as intimidation and threats increase so too do the miracles and visitations from the real sleeping goddess as she awakens once again to bless and protect the world while igniting the hearts and souls of oppressed women everywhere

in a book of deep and telling ironies peter schrag provides essential background for understanding the fractious debate over immigration covering the earliest days of the republic to current events schrag sets the modern immigration controversy within the context of three centuries of debate over the same questions about who exactly is fit for citizenship he finds that nativism has long colored our national history and that the fear and loathing of newcomers has provided one of the faultlines of american cultural and political life schrag describes the eerie similarities between the race based arguments for restricting irish german slav italian jewish and chinese immigrants in the past and the arguments for restricting latinos and others today he links the terrible history of eugenic science to ideas individuals and groups now at the forefront of the fight against rational immigration policies not fit for our society makes a powerful case for understanding the complex often paradoxical history of immigration restriction as we work through the issues that inform and often distort the debate over who can become a citizen who decides and on what basis

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
