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the biography of the last ranee of sarawak born into the aristocracy as sylvia brett in 1885 and destined to become queen of the headhunters jaw dropping if you thought white mischief the last word in english expatriate decadence you haven t yet met sylvia and the brookes the times sylvia brooke was the consort of his highness sir vyner brooke rajah of sarawak the last in a bizarre dynasty of english despots who ruled their jungle kingdom on borneo until 1946 the white rajahs were long held up as model rulers but the spectacularly eccentric behaviour of ranee sylvia self styled queen of the headhunters changed everything this is the compelling story of her part in their downfall

sylvia s lovers is a novel by english novelist and short story writer elizabeth gaskell best known for her novels north and south mary barton and cranford set in the 1790s in an english seaside town sylvia s lovers tells the story of sylvia robson caught between the love of her cousin philip hepburn and whaling harpooner charley kinraid as england

wages war with france press gangs roam the streets when charley is forcibly taken away to fight he asks love rival philip to pass on a message to sylvia but his silence changes their lives forever this haunting tale of love and loss is regarded as one of gaskells finest works elizabeth gaskell 1810 1865 was an english novelist biographer and short story writer renowned for her earnest and detailed descriptions of victorian society among her most famous novels are north and south mary barton and wives and daughters her work has been adapted for film and tv on numerous occasions including the bbc tv drama cranford starring dame judi dench gaskell also wrote the life of charlotte brontë 1857 which was the first ever biography of the famous english writer charlotte brontë

writing circa 731 ce bede professes in the introduction to his historia ecclesiastica gentis anglorum that he will write his account of the past of the english following only vera lex historiae whether explicitly or most often implicitly historians narrate the past according to a conception of what constitutes historical truth that emerges in the use of narrative strategies of certain formulae or textual forms in establishing one s own ideological authority or that of one s informants in faithfulness to a cultural narrative or poetic tradition if we extend the scope of what we understand by history especially in a pre modern setting to include not just the writings of historians legitimated by their belonging to the latinate matrix of christianized classical history writing but also collective narratives practices rituals oral poetry liturgy artistic representations and acts of identity all re enacting the past as or as representation of the present we find a plethora of modes of constructions of historical truth narrative authority and reliability vera lex historiae will be

constituted by contributions that reveal the variety of eventual strategies by which historical truth was constructed in late antiquity and the earlier middle ages and the range of procedures by which such narratives were established first as being historical and then as true histories this is not only a matter of narrative strategies but also habitus ways of living and acting in the world that feed on and back into the commemoration and re enactment of the past by communities and by individuals in doing this we hope to recover something of the plurality of modes of preserving and reenacting the past available in late antiquity and the earlier middle ages which we pass by because of preconceived notions of what constitutes history writing

as a child sylvia loved writing stories and poems sylvia wrote a book from her mother's notes that she had written when she was 75 she was thrilled to read the finished book and it was something that she could pass onto her grandchildren and great grandchildren this encouraged sylvia to write a book of her own it is always good to start at the beginning of life the first chapter covers the second world war from sylvia as a child then peace time to sylvia and margaret starting work at 14 years old then there was time in the women's royal navy known as wrens to marriage family immigration a christian walk growing in the lord jesus christ finishing with poems given to me by the lord jesus christ

a cross cultural comparative view on the transition from a predominant culture of handwriting to a predominant culture of print in the late medieval and early modern periods is provided here combining research on christian and jewish european book culture with findings on east asian manuscript and print culture this approach highlights interactions and interdependencies instead of retracing a linear process from the manuscript book to its printed successor while each chapter is written as a disciplinary study focused on one specific case from the respective field the volume as a whole allows for transcultural perspectives it thereby not only focusses on change but also on simultaneities of manuscript and printing practices as well as on shifts in the perception of

the five little peppers are off to school joel and davie at a boys boarding school polly phronsie and ben at home when the boys come home for the holidays all the children are caught up in plans to help the poor family of a brakeman who was killed in an accident meanwhile polly struggles to keep jasper s friend from being expelled phronsie has a frightening accident and ben works hard to repay mr king margaret sidney was the pen name of harriett mulford lothrop née stone 1844 1924 she was first published at age 34 when two of her stories came out in the boston children s magazine wide awake following their success the editor asked her to write more this led to the publication of her 12 book series five little peppers she married her publisher daniel lothrop and after his death she ran his publishing firm she later sold it so as to have more time to write though the company kept publishing her work together the couple had also bought the mansion the wayside in massachusetts where both louisa may alcott and nathaniel hawthorne had previously lived sidney was a member of the daughters of the american revolution and the founder of the children of the american revolution she wrote over 30 novels

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
