through case studies which widens and deepens opportunities for public participation as new arenas beyond the processes of preparation of development plans are highlighted the book also argues that spaces of public participation in planning are shrinking for example city development plans promoted under the erstwhile jnum programme and several other neoliberal policy regime initiatives have reduced the quality as well as the extent of participatory practices in planning the end result of this is that legally mandated participatory spaces are being used by powerful interests to pursue the neoliberal agenda the volume is divided into three main parts the first part deals with the theory and history of public participation and governance in planning in india and the second presents real life case studies related to planning at a regional level in order to describe and empirically explore some of the theoretical arguments made in the first the third section provides analyses of selected case studies at a local level an introduction and conclusions along with insights for the future provide a coherent envelope to the book
