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this book critically examines the concept of rationality a central theme in economics and management theory through the lens of an analytical philosophy framework alexander styhre advocates for rationality to be grounded in practical reason emphasizing the shared capacity to use language as a means of expressing ideas beliefs and propositional attitudes

with an accessible approach the third european edition of principles of economics provides students with the tools to analyze current economic issues the book is underpinned by a focus on seven core principles which help students to make the link between economic theory and practice the economic naturalist approach supported by exercises problems and examples encourages students to employ economics principles to understand and explain the world around them developed from the well regarded us textbook by frank and bernanke it presents an intuitive approach to economics and is suitable for all students taking a principles of economics course

avoiding excessive reliance on formal mathematical derivations this text presents concepts intuitively through examples drawn from familiar contexts it relies throughout on a shortlist of core principles which it reinforces repeatedly by illustrating and applying each in numerous contexts
