this book reflects on the latest developments in discourse analysis in the context of eu politics research it explores discourse analysis as a tool to study and understand eu politics covering key conceptual methodological and research strategic questions the analytical approach advanced in this book is anchored in discursive institutionalism the newest addition to approaches in new institutionalism the author particularly focuses on discourse as a strategic resource for political purposes as a device for inclusion and exclusion in policy making and as a means of conveying and appealing to political emotions as well as the role visual discourse and imagery play in day to day eu politics including a variety of examples using different combinations of research techniques and data material the book also addresses issues related to the study of discursive structures and agency discourse conflict and consensus causality and the time dimension in discourse analysis

until the recent unauthorized release of thousands of classified state department cables public attention was rarely drawn to the frequently outstanding political analysis done by american diplomats abroad the existing literature on diplomacy has heretofore been limited to memoirs of former diplomats and analyses of international affairs by diplomats academics and think tanks the craft of political analysis offers a fresh approach one that provides a context for interpreting this embassy reporting and a guide to understanding the work that went on behind the scenes to produce it author raymond f smith combines a practitioner s personal view of what is required to do good diplomatic political analysis with his understanding of the social conflict and change that informed his work for the state department smith clearly explains everything the foreign service candidate or professional as well as the interested layman needs to know about crafting political analysis including how to write for the analyst s intended audience how to make best use of the intellectual and analytical tools of the trade what happens when the analyst s views differ from government policy and why political analysis risks becoming irrelevant even though it is still urgently needed in addition the craft of political analysis for diplomats features two case studies using legally declassified cables not included in the wikileaks release the first is built around four highly restricted embassy moscow cables on the collapse of the soviet union the second includes two cables on the arab israeli conflict that received the state department s highest award for political analysis selected for the diplomats and diplomacy series of the association for diplomatic studies and training adst and dacor an organization of foreign affairs professionals

topless bars casino gambling needle exchange programs for drug addicts there is no question morality issues remain front and center in urban politics presenting a systematic analysis of culture war issues at the local level Elaine Sharp shows how American cities deal with these ongoing concerns drawing on a sample of ten strategically chosen cities she explains differences in how municipalities respond to controversies surrounding sex business abortion clinics legalized gambling gay rights and drug use by analyzing the relative importance of subculture economics and institutional arrangements in the disputes she points the way toward richer and more complete understanding of how different cities respond differently to these hot button issues far more than a statistical study morality politics in American cities is a collection of fascinating stories of real people grappling with down to earth issues and real life drama richly informative case studies that will captivate students and interested citizens alike mayors public health directors activists and others speak their minds about the pros and cons of these controversies here are officials in one city confronting the Vatican over funding for abortion services those in another battling a local university over its refusal to provide health benefits to gay partners of faculty members and still others mounting a massive community sponsored attack on topless clubs these stories provide detailed evidence to support classifications needed for comparing cities experience with each of the five morality issues they also corroborate inferences drawn from the comparisons by showing what considerations were in play as local officials grappled with these issues overall the study shows that cultural factors usually dominate policymaking in local politics except when specific economic interests are at stake and also observes that county level governments are more important than previously thought in terms of morality issue decisions as provocative as it is informative morality politics in American cities demonstrates that such issues same sex marriage for example are multidimensional and often difficult to resolve its conclusions however contingent mark an important step in the ongoing process of understanding important differences in approaches to these issues and clearly show how moral conflicts continue to define American politics

Loomis observed the politics of policymaking in Kansas from May 1988 through May 1989 using specific examples he shows how deadlines occur in regular predictable patterns in the development of issues in subsequent policy decisions and explains how they ultimately narrow the choices presented to any legislative body

In the past twenty years the study of urban politics has shifted from a predominant concern with political culture and ethos to a preoccupation with political economy particularly that of urban development urban scholars have come to recognize that cities are shaped by forces beyond their boundaries from that focus have emerged the views that cities are clearly engaged in economic competition that market processes are shaped by national policy decisions sometimes intentionally and sometimes inadvertently and that the costs and benefits of economic growth are unevenly distributed but what else needs to be said about the policies and politics of urban development to supplement prevailing theories the politics of urban development argues that the role of local actors in making development decisions merits closer study

whatever the structural constraints politics still matters collectively the essays provide ample evidence that local government officials and other community actors do not simply follow the imperatives that derive from the national political economy they are able to assert a significant degree of influence over the shared destiny of an urban population the impact of the collection is to heighten awareness of local political practices and of how and why they make a difference
