elected governor in 1853 and re elected in 1855 and returned to the governorship as an interim appointee from 1867 to 1869 during reconstruction his achievements in all these positions were substantial pease was also a highly successful and respected lawyer and a large landholder with properties in travis and many other texas counties he owned slaves but he did not take a strong proslavery position and when secession came in 1861 he continued to support the union he and his family remained in austin during the civil war and when it ended he did his best to heal wounds and restore texas to the united states in a second appointment as governor lucadia nils pease married marshall pease in 1850 and came to texas as a newlywed she was known as the governor s lady moreover her early independent travel and her stated position as a woman s rights woman in the 1850s as well as her support for sending a daughter away to college in the 1870s to earn a degree all serve as markers of her intelligence and the strength of her convictions to tell their story whitlow mined thousands of letters and papers saved by the pease family and housed in the austin history center of the austin public library as well as in the governor s papers at the texas state library and archives commission e m pease observed near the end of his life that he had been one of the people of texas since the colonial days of stephen f austin he and lucadia left an extraordinary historical record that documents the development of texas
