the government must show how the excellent medical care being delivered to injured service personnel will continue long after the memory of the afghan operation fades this report which gives praise to the first class medical treatment provided for the armed forces questions whether the support for injured personnel will be sustainable over the long term in particular the committee is concerned about the number of people who may go on to develop severe and life limiting physical mental health alcohol or neurological problems there is still a question mark over whether the government as a whole fully understands the likely future demands and related costs

across the ages technological developments have been accelerated by the military this results from the fact that able bodied vibrant youths are generally involved and are also exposed to high tech training prevailing at their times for assignments defence and security that are essential but not desired they form the armed forces for the nations such brilliant military officers like caesar and napoleon made their marks and in contemporary times the armed forces of united states france britain australia etc are making remarkable contributions to technological developments such infrastructure as the internet the gps and the cell phones are products that have significant military contributions this book scans across the major regions of the world highlights the efforts of representative countries in the regions and observes that nations that have harnessed the efforts of their armed forces have progressively developed it is also observed that developments in america and europe though not entirely dependent on their armed forces have been greatly affected by their efforts in asia such countries as the people s republic of china brazil india pakistan and singapore utilise the human and material resources within the armed forces for national growth and cohesion development effort is least in the african region except south africa and egypt notwithstanding the high

potentials as exhibited by nigeria s armed forces although attempts to industrialise through the armed forces may be able to create economic development for developing nations such factors as historical background economic resources political climate government policies and infrastructure are equally important economic development programme of an aspiring country should i promote education and access to knowledge ii aspire to economic self sufficiency in economic power iii allow and promote private sector and foreign participation in defence production research and development iv commit itself to the establishment and support of defence industries v indigenise defence programmes establish a balance between military and economic development and vi mobilise the nation s economy through technology partnership with the private sector and foreign investors

civil military cooperation cimic is the relationship between militaries and humanitarians this book demonstrates the wide variety of national approaches to cimic activities introducing some theoretical and ethical considerations into a field that has largely been bereft of this type of debate

the united states has used military force short of war as an instrument of diplomacy on many occasions and in many areas of the world in the years since the second world war this book describes and analyzes the circumstances accompanying 215 shows of force and examines how effective these actions were in helping to attain u s foreign policy objectives which type of force air ground naval was most often used what did the forces do and how effective were they of what significance was soviet involvement when u s military power was called upon to influence events was the threat presented by the alerting or deployment of strategic nuclear forces or by very large conventional forces especially telling how clear is it that a desired effect was in fact caused by the demonstration of force barry blechman and stephen kaplan explore these and other questions examining also such elements as a president s domestic popularity and personal diplomacy preceding or during crises that led to u s military demonstrations complementing their analysis are five sets of case studies describing ten instances of the use of american military power to influence events in central and eastern europe the middle east south and southeast asia and the caribbean the case studies by david k hall

william b quandt jerome n slater robert m slusser and philip windsor focus on the reasons for u s action and the methods adopted on the behavior of other parties and on the relation between the use of force and the resolution of the crisis the book s main conclusion is that the demonstrative use of u s armed forces has often stabilized a deteriorating situation enough to avoid further deterioration relieved domestic and international pressure for more drastic and possibly self defeating action and gained time for diplomacy to achieve a more lasting remedy

until recently internal use of the armed forces has been generally regarded by the public as well as academic commentators as conduct to be expected of a military or autocratic regime not a democratic government there is however growing concern that the war on terror has been used to condition public opinion to accept the internal deployment of the armed forces including for broader industrial and political purposes this book examines the national and international law human rights and civil liberties issues involved in governments calling out troops to deal with civil unrest or terrorism as the introduction of military call out legislation has become an emerging global trend in the opening years of the 21st century there is considerable and growing interest in the constitutional and related problems surrounding the deployment of military forces for domestic purposes examining the changes underway in six comparable countries the united states canada britain germany japan and australia this book provides a review and analysis of this trend including its implications for legal and political rights

the purpose of this study is to analyze the political role of the venezuelan military from the death of gen juan vicente gomez in 1935 to the presidency of romulo betancourt in 1959 this analysis should contribute to a clearer understanding of the nature of military involvement in the national politics of a medium sized latin american nation it should also serve as an additional case study for the comparative analysis of military politics in this hemisphere

how do we understand the functions of militaries of democratic societies how good soldiers are made how they behave when posted overseas the issue of gender and the increased use of military beyond their core functions all demand a closer academic examination this edited collection brings together work by exciting new scholars as well

as established academics and examines the identity and functions of the new zealand army from a range of perspectives drawing on anthropology political studies international relations development studies law and defence and security studies it provides a multi faceted view of one military organisation and helps further our understanding of the character and the challenges of military personnel and institutions in the twenty first century

throughout history innovations in military technology have transformed warfare which in turn affected state formation this interplay between warfare military technology and state formation is the focus of this text theoretically grounded in the bellicist approach to the study of war and state which posits that war is a normal part of human experience the book argues that the threat of war by powerful predatory neighbors has been until relatively recently the prime mover of state formation using a historical approach it explains how advances in military technology have transformed war and how new modes of war in turn have transformed forms of politico military rule especially with regard to the relationship between the state armed force and the people

this book investigates the use and utility of military force in modern war after the cold war western armed forces have increasingly been called upon to intervene in internal conflicts in the former third world these forces have been called upon to carry out missions that they traditionally have not been trained and equipped for in environments that they often have not been prepared for a number of these new types of operations in allegedly new wars stand out such as peace enforcement state building counter insurgency humanitarian aid and not the least counter terrorism the success rate of these missions has however been mixed providing fuel for an increasingly loud debate on the utility of force in modern war this edited volume poses as its central question what is in fact the utility of force is force useful for anything other than a complete conventional defeat of a regular opponent who is confronted in the open field this book will be of much interest to students of strategic studies war and conflict studies counter insurgency security studies and ir isabelle duyvesteyn is an associate professor at the department of history of international relations utrecht university in the netherlands jan angstrom is a researcher at the swedish national defence college

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
