agriculture dominates the rural economy of papua new guinea png more than five million rural dwellers 80 of the population earn a living from subsistence agriculture and selling crops in domestic and international markets many aspects of agriculture in png are described in this data rich book topics include agricultural environments in which crops are grown production of food crops cash crops and animals land use soils demography migration the macro economic environment gender issues governance of agricultural institutions and transport the history of agriculture over the 50 000 years that png has been occupied by humans is summarised much of the information presented is not readily available within png the book contains results of many new analyses including a food budget for the entire nation the text is supported by 165 tables and 215 maps and figures

securing village life development in late colonial papua new guinea examines the significance for post world war ii australian colonial policy of the modern idea of development australian officials emphasised the importance of bringing development for both the colony of papua and the united nations trust territory of new guinea the principal form that development took involved securing smallholders against the tendencies of other forms of capitalist development that might have separated households

from land in order to make household occupation of their holdings more secure and at higher standards of living the colonial administration coordinated and supervised increases in production of crops and other agricultural produce contrary to suggestions that colonial policy and practice ignored indigenous agriculture and concentrated on plantation crops grown by international firms and expatriate owner occupiers the study shows how the main focus was instead upon increasing smallholder output for immediate consumption as well as for local and international markets simultaneously development stimulated increases in consumption including of goods produced through manufacturing processes and imported into the colony only as independence approached was the pre eminence of the earlier focus upon smallholders weakened in part the change occurred due to the political advance of the indigenous capitalist class and their allies seeking to extend their base in largeholding agriculture and related commercial activities this advance and the uncertainty over which form of development would prevail once indigenes held state power in post colonial papua new guinea stood in marked contrast to the definite direction pursued under the colonial administration of the 1950s and early 1960s

one of the major river systems of our country the purari river finds its outlet to the sea in the gulf of papua on the southern coast of papua new guinea all highlands provinces contribute to this mighty river the erave of the southern highlands province joins with the kaugel and wahgi rivers western high lands the tua river simbu and asaro and aure rivers of the eastern high lands province to make the purari the third largest river in p n g unlike its rivals the fly and the sepik the distance between its escape from the mountains and its entrance to the sea is short after winding its way mostly through deep gorges flanked by high mountains the river leaves the foothills of the southern slopes of the central cordillera barely eighty kilometers from the sea the energy potential of such a river is enormous could the waters be utilised in any way to the advantage of the nation twelve years ago the electricity com mission of papua new guinea proposed an answer to this question the building of a dam across the river in the wabo area of the gulf province the generation of vast quantities of hydro electric power could be fed into a national distribution grid and heavy industries could be established in the gulf province and other suitable localities to benefit from this power

abstract program planning and problems for nutrition development are discussed quarterly reports the food and nutrition policy

and the results of a nutrition workshop and national survey are presented the government of papua new guinea is stressing nutrition planning trying to limit food imports while increasing commercial and subsistence food production and emphasizing nutrition education since malnourished children under five years suffer the most they have received the greatest scrutiny from the country s nutritionists malnutrition is considered a major contributing factor in over half of hospital deaths of children five and under recent studies have shown decreases in malnutrition rates among young children from 1975 to 1978

people have adequate food security when households have the capacity to access sufficient food at all times either through self production or through market purchases overall food security is high in png as most rural people have access to land and can grow most of their food requirements the food security situation is considerably better in png now than it was before the pacific war this is because high yield staple crops have been adopted and people have access to cash income that can be used to purchase food the adoption of new staple crops provided a once off benefit however this phase is now ending in png this proceedings contains the 120 papers presented at the papua new guinea food and nutrition 2000 conference held at the png university of technology in lae from 26 30 june 2000
