the papers in this volume represent most of the contributions to the symposium on the physics of opto electronic materials held at the general motors research lab oratories in warren michigan on october 4 5 and 6 1970 the purpose of this symposium was to examine the current status of knowledge related to the controlled alteration of the optical properties of solids through exter nally applied agencies with the aim of assessing possible future directions of scientific effort to achieve efficient practical control of light since the advent of the laser the scientific community has been motivated to explore with a renewed vigor methods of modulating light and in the last decade several applications of the electrooptic effect in single crystal solids have been real ized during this same period of time the list of recognized optical modulation ef fects in solids exclusive of the ordinary electrooptic effects has grown rapidly and recently dramatic demonstrations of light modulation by liquid crystal and ferro electric ceramic materials have captured the attention of the scientific community unlike the single crystal electrooptic effects which are quite suitable for modulation of coherent laser light these latter materials promise

relatively inexpensive approaches to the modulation of light from ordinary incoherent light sources it was these new vistas of light modulation and how they fit into our current understanding of the optical properties of solids that the symposium addressed

a multidisciplinary study of a term rapidly returning to the forefront of contemporary theory matt potolsky examines the key issues surrounding the term mimesis including an exploration of the work of freud lacan girard and baudrillard

beginning from the notion of finite life another finitude takes this staple subject from post heideggerian philosophy and opposes it to the onto theological concept of infinity represented by an eternal absolute although critical of heidegger and his definition of finitude as being towards death this book does not revert to the ontological idea of infinity secured in the sacred image of immortality but it also does not want to give up on infinity altogether the infinite is transposed so it can become a necessary moment of the finite life a theological framework for the new elaboration of the concept of finitude is crucial but instead of following the lutheran formula agata bielik robson turns to the sources of judaism taking inspiration from the jewish idea of torat havim the principle of finite life which found the best expression in the biblical sentence love strong as death love emerges as the alternative marker of finitude allowing to us redefine it in an affirmative way by tracing the avatars of love in the group of 20th century thinkers or messianic vitalists benjamin rosenzweig arendt derrida and deeply revised freud the book attempts to demonstrate the possibility of such affirmation love becomes the new infinite in the finite love in all its forms from the original libidinal endowment of the human psyche to the last metamorphoses of agape the greco christian divine love
