orientalism and literature discusses a key critical concept in literary studies and how it assists our reading of literature it reviews the concept s evolution how it has been explored imagined and narrated in literature part i considers orientalism s origins and its geographical and multidisciplinary scope then considers the major genres and trends orientalism inspired in the literary critical field such as the eighteenth century oriental tale reading the bible and victorian oriental fiction part ii recaptures specific aspects of edward said s orientalism the multidisciplinary contexts and scholarly discussions it has inspired such as colonial discourse race resistance feminism and travel writing part iii deliberates upon recent and possible future applications of orientalism probing its currency and effectiveness in the twenty first century the role it has played and continues to play in the operation of power and how in new forms neo orientalism and islamophobia it feeds into various genres from migrant writing to journalism

this book examines the modes of representation of the east in argentinean literature since the country s independence in works by canonical authors such as esteban echeverr a juan b alberdi domingo f sarmiento lucio v mansilla pastor s obligado eduardo f wilde leopoldo lugones and roberto arlt the east which has always fascinated intellectuals and artists from the americas inspired the creation of imaginary elements for both aesthetic and political purposes from the depiction of purportedly despotic rulers to a genuine admiration for eastern history and millennial cultures these writers appropriated the east either through their travels or by reading chronicles integrating along the way images that would end up being universalized by the argentinean dichotomy between civilization and barbarism all the while assigning the negative stereotypes of the exotic east to the pampa region with time the exoticism of the eastern world would shed its geopolitical meaning and was ultimately integrated into the national literature thus adding new elements into the argentinean imaginary

the origin of literary orientalism is in the various military religious diplomatic political and socio cultural encounters between and christian west and the islamic east major works of western literature and art contain references to oriental cultures often emphasizing cultural differences in

acknowledging the significance of edward said s orientalism for contemporary discourse the contributors to this volume deconstruct rearrange and challenge elements of his thesis looking at the new conditions and opportunities offered by globalization what can a renewed or reconceptualized orientalism teach us about the force and limits of our racial imaginary specifically in relation to various national contexts in what ways for example considering our greater cross cultural interaction have clichés and stereotypes undergone a metamorphosis in contemporary societies and cultures theoretically and empirically this book offers an expansive

range of contexts comprising the insights analytical positions and perspectives of a transnational team of scholars of comparative literature and literary and cultural studies based in australia hong kong japan malaysia usa singapore taiwan and turkey working with through and beyond orientalism they examine a variety of cultural texts including the novel short story poetry film graphic memoir social thought and life writing making connections across centuries and continents they articulate cultural representation and discourse through multiple approaches including critical content analysis historical contextualization postcolonial theory gender theory performativity intertextuality and intersectionality given its unique approach this book will be essential reading for scholars of literary theory film studies and asian studies as well as for those with a general interest in postcolonial literature and film

individually and collectively these essays establish a new direction for scholarship that examines the crucial activities of reading and writing about literature and how they relate to authenticity though authenticity is a term deep in literary resonance and rich in philosophical complexity its connotations relative to the study of literature have rarely been explored or exploited through detailed critical examination of individual writers and their works here the notion of the authentic is recognised first and foremost as central to a range of literary and philosophical ways of thinking particularly for nineteenth century poets and novelists distinct from studies of literary fakes and forgeries this collection focuses on authenticity as a central paradigm for approaching literature and its formation that bears on issues of authority self reliance truth originality the valid and the real and the genuine and inauthentic whether applied to the self or others topics and authors include the spiritual autobiographies of william cowper and john newton ruskin and travel writing british romantic women poets william wordsworth and p b shelley robert southey and anna seward john keats lord byron elizabeth gaskell henry david thoreau henry irving and joseph conrad the volume also includes a note on professor vincent newey with a bibliography of his critical writings

a great deal of stimulating and valuable discussion as well as some indignation and hot air has been stimulated by edward said whose provocative study of orientalism western conceptions of the orient appeared twenty years ago this present book will we believe be recognized as a worthy addition to the many attempts that have since been made to sift the intrinsic and ingrained attitudes of west to east the fifteen articles in oriental prospects western literature and the lure of the east cover literature from the renaissance through the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries to the modern period some in pragmatic accounts of responses to and uses of experiences of the orient and its cultural attitudes and artefacts others contending more

theoretically with issues that Edward Said has raised despite all the misunderstanding prejudice and propaganda in the scholarly and literary depiction of the Orient still today as in the past what emerges from this wide range of articles is that no species of literary text or academic study can appear without risking the accusation of escapist exoticism or cultural and economic exploitation and thus regrettably masking the essential and vital significance of the political and the real and imaginative trading between East and West

Islam and Romantic Orientalism will be of great interest to those concerned with the debate about Orientalism and Postcolonialism and to students of nineteenth century English literature

At the heart of this book is a spectral theory of world literature that draws on Edward Said, Homi K. Bhabha, Jacques Derrida and World Systems Theory to assess how the field produces local literature as an *Other* that haunts its universalising assimilative imperative with the force of the uncanny. It takes the Middle Eastern novel as both metonym and metaphor of a spectral world literature. It explores the worlding of novels from the Middle East in recent years and focusing on the pivotal sites of Middle Eastern modernity: Egypt, Turkey, Iran, argues that lost to their global production, circulation and reception is their constitution in the logic of spectrality. With the intention of redressing this imbalance, it critically restores their engagements with the Others of Middle Eastern modernity and shows through a new reading of the Middle Eastern novel that world literature is always already haunted by its Others, the ghosts of modernity.

Orientalist Poetics is the only book on literary Orientalism that spans the nineteenth century in both England and France with particular attention to poetry and poetics. It convincingly demonstrates Orientalism's centrality to the evolution of poetry and poetics in both nations and provides a singularly comprehensive and definitive analysis of the aesthetic impact of Orientalism on nineteenth century poetry because it examines the poetry of the entire century across both national literatures. The book is in a unique position to articulate the essential part Orientalism plays in major developments of nineteenth century poetics through probing discussions of an array of prominent nineteenth century poets including Shelley, Southey, Byron, Hugo, Musset, Leconte de Lisle, Wordsworth, Hemans, Gautier, Tennyson, Arnold and Wilde. Emily A. Haddad reveals how Orientalism functions as a diffuse avant-garde, a crucial medium for the cultivation and refinement

of a broad range of experimental positions on poetry and poetics haddad argues that while orientalist poems are often viewed mainly as artefacts of european attitudes towards the east and imperialism poetic representations of the islamic orient also provide an indispensable matrix for the reexamination of such aesthetically fundamental issues as the purpose of poetry the value of mimesis and the relationship between nature and art orientalist poetics effectively bridges the gap between the analysis of poetics and the analysis of orientalism in showing that major poetic developments have roots in orientalism haddad s book offers a valuable and innovative revisionist view of nineteenth century literary history

a guide to the thesis literature on china and inner asia written between 1976 and 1990 includes more than 10 000 entries for dissertations in the arts and sciences law medicine theology engineering and other disciplines entries are grouped in topical chapters and each entry includes bibliographic information and an abstract
