a number of well developed theories shed light on the question under what circumstances our beliefs enjoy epistemic justification yet comparatively little is known about epistemic defeat when new information causes the loss of epistemic justification this book proposes and defends a detailed account of epistemic defeaters the main kinds of defeaters are analyzed in detail and integrated into a general framework that aims to explain how beliefs lose justification it is argued that defeaters introduce incompatibilities into a noetic system and thereby prompt a structured re evaluation process that makes a justified reinstatement of the defeated belief impossible the account is then applied to the topic of disagreement where it is used in an argument for conciliationism as well as a new explanation for higher order defeat throughout the book the notion of defeat is the center of attention while a number of new issues are discussed at the intersections of defeat and justification specifically

new problems are raised for broadly internalist accounts of defeat a fully descriptive reliabilist account of defeat is provided and the case for normative defeat is revisited

this book presents an original discussion and analysis of epistemic peer disagreement it reviews a wide range of cases from the literature and extends the definition of epistemic peerhood with respect to the current one to account for the actual variability found in real world examples the book offers a number of arguments supporting the variability in the nature and in the range of disagreements and outlines the main benefits of disagreement among peers i e what the author calls the benefits to inquiry argument
