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come back to thunder point from the 1 new york times bestselling author of the virgin river series book 3 in her beloved thunder point novels where falling in love can be the bravest act of all in a moment of desperation devon mcallister takes her daughter and flees a place where they should have been safe and secure she has no idea what is around the next bend but she is pretty certain it can t be worse than what they ve left behind her plan is to escape to somewhere she can be invisible instead an unexpected offer of assistance leads her to thunder point a tiny oregon town with a willingness to help someone in need as the widowed father

of a vulnerable young boy spencer lawson knows something about needing friendship but he s not looking for anything else instead he s thrown his energy into his new role as thunder point s high school football coach tough and demanding to his team off the field he s gentle and kind just the kind of man who could heal devon s wounded heart devon thought she wanted to hide from the world but in thunder point you find bravery where you least expect it and sometimes you find a hero originally published in 2013

emily carr often called canada s van gogh was a post impressionist explorer artist and writer in artist emily carr and the spirit of the land phyllis marie jensen draws on analytical psychology and the theories of feminism and social constructionism for insights into carr s life in the late victorian period and early twentieth century presented in two parts the book introduces carr s émigré english family and childhood on the edge of nowhere and her art education in san francisco london and paris travels in the wilderness introduced her to the totem art of the pacific northwest coast at a time aboriginal art was undervalued and believed to be disappearing carr vowed to document it before turning to spirited landscapes of forest sea and sky the second part of the book presents a jungian portrait of carr including typology psychological complexes and archetypal features of personality an examination the individuation process and carr s embracement of transcendental philosophy reveals the richness of her personality and artistic genius artist emily carr and the spirit of the land provides captivating reading for analytical psychologists academics and students of jungian studies art history health gender and women s studies

a hero s journey beyond little norway and olympia sports camp is a compiled history of the olympia sports camp in huntsville ontario through the lens of its founder and inspiration dave grace the hero of the book s title the hero s journey of the title is dave grace s adaptation of the writings and teaching of philosopher joseph campbell the basic tenet of the dave grace s hero s journey is that heroes all go through a 12 step journey from their own comfort zone to the unknown and all its challenges to a new normal where the hero bestows knowledge learned on others in order to help them on their journey dave grace s foundational belief is that we are all heroes on our own path and who we become on our journey is more important than the accomplishments we achieve a hero s journey chronicles the people and places that make up the history of the camp while also serving as an inspirational guidebook for readers to each become the hero of their own journey this book also examines the history of the land on which the camp has been built from its indigenous origins to the european settlement of the 1800s and to the use of the land by the norwegian air force during world war ii the book takes readers on a journey through the various stages related to the development of the camp first established in 1974 the book is built on a collection of stories related to mentorship sports psychology and community building as well as interviews of past campers coaches and others with a longtime association with olympia with this book author chris dooley honours dave grace and the many others who have been integral to the history of the camp and its land

a richly textured account of what it means to be poor in america baltimore was once a vibrant manufacturing town but today with factory closings and steady job loss since the 1970s it is home to some of the most impoverished neighborhoods in america the hero s fight provides an intimate look at the effects of deindustrialization on the lives of baltimore s urban poor and sheds critical light on the unintended consequences of welfare policy on our most vulnerable communities drawing on her own uniquely immersive brand of fieldwork conducted over the course of a decade in the neighborhoods of west baltimore patricia fernández kelly tells the stories of people like d b wilson big floyd towanda and others whom the american welfare state treats with a mixture of contempt and pity what fernández kelly calls ambivalent benevolence she shows how growing up poor in the richest nation in the world involves daily interactions with agents of the

state an experience that differs significantly from that of more affluent populations while ordinary americans are treated as citizens and consumers deprived and racially segregated populations are seen as objects of surveillance containment and punishment fernández kelly provides new insights into such topics as globalization and its effects on industrial decline and employment the changing meanings of masculinity and femininity among the poor social and cultural capital in poor neighborhoods and the unique roles played by religion and entrepreneurship in destitute communities blending compelling portraits with in depth scholarly analysis the hero s fight explores how the welfare state contributes to the perpetuation of urban poverty in america

for a generation alan m wald s the new york intellectuals has stood as the authoritative account of an often misunderstood chapter in the history of a celebrated tradition among literary radicals in the united states his passionate investigation of over half a century of dissident marxist thought jewish internationalism fervent political activism and the complex art of the literary imagination is enriched by more than one hundred personal interviews unparalleled primary research and critical interpretations of novels and short stories depicting the inner lives of committed writers and thinkers wald s commanding biographical portraits of rebel outsiders who mostly became insiders retains its resonance today and includes commentary on max eastman elliot cohen lionel trilling sidney hook tess slesinger philip rahv mary mccarthy james t farrell irving kristol irving howe hannah arendt and more with a new preface by the author that tracks the rebounding influence of these intellectuals in the era of occupy and bernie sanders this anniversary edition shows that the trajectory and ideological ordeals of the new york intellectual left still matters today

the sea doesn t forget it knows all of this has happened before and will happen again 1840 as a vast ship loses its way in the night time mist shattering against the cliffs of crescombe north devon a daring young artist dives into the murky sea but it s not for heroism he is risking all something or someone is drawing him into those dark perilous waters by dawn only his legacy will survive now when finley arrives in crescombe for the summer he suspects he s not alone in his attic bedroom before long he is uncovering secrets the remote seaside town has kept for almost two centuries about ghosts and curses about a ruthless old smuggling family and about the young women whose bodies have washed up along the town s rocky shoreline just below his porthole window yet the more finley learns the further he s bonded to those who have gone before him and the closer he comes to meeting the same watery end but this is not just a story about death it s about love it s about fate and how ultimately the past can pull you under praise for the lost storyteller a powerful novel about how stories connect us all jenny colgan a warm immersive read that weaves folklore through a story of self discovery kate sawyer a moving story and vivid characters but it also has that special indefinable

marina carr and greek tragedy examines the feminist transposition of greek tragedy in the theatre of the contemporary irish dramatist marina carr through a comparison of the plays based on classical drama with their ancient models it investigates carr s transformation not only of the narrative but also of the form of greek tragedy as a religious and political institution of the 5th century athenian democracy tragedy endorsed the sexist oppression of women indeed the construction of female characters in greek tragedy was entirely disconnected from the experience of womanhood lived by real women in order to embody the patriarchal values of athenian democracy whether praised for their passivity or demonized for showing unnatural agency and subjectivity women in greek tragedy were conceived to reassert the supremacy of men carr s theatre stands in stark opposition to such a purpose focusing on women s struggle to achieve agency and subjectivity in a male dominated world her plays show the diversity of experiencing womanhood and sexist oppression in the republic of ireland and the western societies more generally yet carr s enduring conversation with the classics in her theatre demonstrates the feminist willingness to alter the founding myths of western civilisation to advocate for gender equality

first published in 1982 people care about places inhabitants demand more participation in the changes proposed for their local environments activists urge greater protection of countryside and natural environments decision makers feel threatened by the antagonism aroused by their powers and plans the essays in this book have been drawn together to discover what lies behind these expressions of concern and discontent valued environments are places for which people feel commitment and affection places which support a sense of personal identity and well being the authors explore the character and constituents of valued environments asking how our experiences of environments may be enhanced what is the impact of environmental change how can the future be accommodated in both rural and urban environments without destroying their essential qualities the reader will find substantive evidence from case studies of environments valued by inhabitants and outsiders which answer these questions examples are taken from wilderness areas fenland market towns and large cities commercial streets and residential neighbourhoods environments of the past and those imagined in science fiction the essays are united in their focus on the meaning of places and landscapes the subtle but highly significant role of valued environments is examined thoroughly in the book it will be of interest to all who care deeply about their surroundings reflecting perhaps some of their own experiences as well as conveying information about the environmental experiences of others students of geography environmental planning and conservation should also find the book directly relevant to their interests in man environment relationships
