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the roots of romanticism is the long awaited text of isaiah berlin s most celebrated set of lectures the mellon lectures delivered in washington in 1965 and heard since by a much wider audience on bbc radio for berli the romantics set in train a

vast unparalleled revolution in humanity's view of itself they destroyed the traditional notion of objective truth in ethics with incalculable all pervasive results in his unscripted tour de force Berlin surveys the myriad attempts to define romanticism distills its essence traces its development and shows how its legacy permeates our outlook today

the romantic era in England and Germany saw a sudden renewal of prophetic modes of writing biblical prophecy and to a lesser extent classical oracle again became viable models for poetry and even for journalistic prose notably this development arose out of the new found freedom of biblical interpretation that began in the mid eighteenth century as the Bible was increasingly seen to be a literary and mythical text taking Walter Benjamin's thinking about history as a point of departure the author shows how the model for romantic prophecy emerges less as a prediction of the future than as a call to change in the present even as it quotes at key turns texts from the past after surveying developments in eighteenth century biblical hermeneutics as well as the numerous instances of prophetic eruption in romantic poetry the book culminates in close readings of works by Blake, Hölderlin and Coleridge each of these writers interpreted the Bible in strong variously radical and conservative ways and each reworked prophetic texts in often startling fashion the author's reading of Blake focuses on the complex temporal and rhetorical dynamics at work in a prophetic tradition with attention paid to the key mediating figure of Milton the chapter on Hölderlin investigates the truth claim of poetry and the consequences of Hölderlin's insight into the necessarily figural character of poetry the analysis of Coleridge correlates his theory of allegory and symbol with his theory and practice of political writing which often relies on mobilizing prophetic authority together the readings force us to reexamine the claims and practices of romantic poets and thinkers and their ideas and ideologies not without engendering some allegorical resonance with issues in our own time

the cold war roots of liberalism's present crisis a daring new book Becca Rothfeld Washington Post a fascinating and combative intellectual history Gideon Rachman Financial Times by the middle of the twentieth century many liberals looked glumly at the world modernity had brought about with its devastating wars rising totalitarianism and permanent nuclear terror they concluded that far from offering a solution to these problems the ideals of the enlightenment including emancipation and equality had instead created them the historian of political thought Samuel Moyn argues that the liberal intellectuals of

the cold war era among them isaiah berlin gertrude himmelfarb karl popper judith shklar and lionel trilling transformed liberalism but left a disastrous legacy for our time in his iconoclastic style moyn outlines how cold war liberals redefined the ideals of their movement and renounced the moral core of the enlightenment for a more dangerous philosophy preserving individual liberty at all costs in denouncing this stance as well as the recent nostalgia for cold war liberalism as a means to counter illiberal values moyn presents a timely call for a new emancipatory and egalitarian liberal philosophy a path to undoing the damage of the cold war and to ensuring the survival of liberalism

the nineteenth century romantic understanding of history is often confused with the longing for the past golden age in this book the golden age is seen from a new angle by discussing it in the context of the works of friedrich schlegel who saw it not as bygone but to be produced in the future

shows that modernism was concocted out of surprising sources and that one of them was toryism during 1900 1920

i was exhausted at the end yet i am sure that if ever i saw heard anyone in a true state of inspiration it was then so wrote a listener to her friend after attending one of the lectures based on the book political ideas in the romantic age is the text berlin wrote for four of the lectures delivered in 1952 he revised what he had written extensively afterwards but never published it it is his longest work and also the only connected account he gave of his key insights into the history of the ideas that dominate the political arguments of our own time as he put it in his prologue the age of which we speak was singularly rich in original conceptions they transformed our world and the words in which they were formulated speak to us
