the roots of romanticism is the long awaited text of isaiah berlin s most celebrated set of lectures the mellon lectures delivered in washington in 1965 and heard since by a much wider audience on bbc radio for berli the romantics set in train a

vast unparalleled revolution in humanity s view of itself they destroyed the traditional notion of objective truth in ethicsm with incalculable all pervasive results in his unscripted tour de force berlin surveys the myriad attempts to define romanticism distils its essence traces its development and shows how its legacy permeates our outlook today

the romantic era in england and germany saw a sudden renewal of prophetic modes of writing biblical prophecy and to a lesser extent classical oracle again became viable models for poetry and even for journalistic prose notably this development arose out of the new found freedom of biblical interpretation that began in the mid eighteenth century as the bible was increasingly seen to be a literary and mythical text taking walter benjamin s thinking about history as a point of departure the author shows how the model for romantic prophecy emerges less as a prediction of the future than as a call to change in the present even as it quotes at key turns texts from the past after surveying developments in eighteenth century biblical hermeneutics as well as the numerous instances of prophetic eruption in romantic poetry the book culminates in close readings of works by blake h Iderlin and coleridge each of these writers interpreted the bible in strong variously radical and conservative ways and each reworked prophetic texts in often startling fashion the author s reading of blake focuses on the complex temporal and rhetorical dynamics at work in a prophetic tradition with attention paid to the key mediating figure of milton the chapter on h Iderlin investigates the truth claim of poetry and the consequences of h Iderlin s insight into the necessarily figural character of poetry the analysis of coleridge correlates his theory of allegory and symbol with his theory and practice of political writing which often relies on mobilizing prophetic authority together the readings force us to reexamine the claims and practices of romantic poets and thinkers and their ideas and ideologies not without engendering some allegorical resonance with issues in our own time
