this book offers a timely exploration of the still burgeoning field of international political theory ipt ipt is approached in this volume not merely as a subfield at the margins of the discipline of international relations ir but rather as a key dimension of theorising international relations that challenges disciplinary theoretical methodological and geographical boundaries and insemminates other theoretical ir traditions chapters in this volume approach ipt as a theoretical tradition that emphasises and interrogates the philosophical historical ethical normative institutional and aesthetic dimensions of international relations and world politics in so doing they explore ipt as a european theoretical tradition to stress that paradoxically it is only by provincializing europe and its intellectual traditions that one may finally appreciate what is truly universal in them this is a refreshingly different take on ipt sure to be of interest to students and scholars of ipt ir and political theory

published in 1991 the self determination of minorities in international politics is a valuable contribution to the field of politics

cities have become increasingly important to global politics but have largely occupied a peripheral place in the academic study of international relations ir this is a notable oversight for the discipline although one which may be explained by ir's traditional state centrism the subjugation of the city to the demands of the territorial state in the modern period and a lack of conceptual and analytical frameworks that can allow scholars to include the impact of cities within their work presenting case specific scholarship from leading experts in the field each contribution guides the reader through the changing nature of cities in the international system and their increasing prominence in global governance outcomes the book features case studies on the financial power of cities city action in the security domain collaboration of cities in coping with environmental

problems transnational urban regions and mayors as international actors to illustrate if the relationship between the city and the state has changed in profound ways and how cities are empowered by structural changes in world politics the multidisciplinary and global focus in the power of cities in international relations sheds much needed light on the significance of the reemergence of cities from the long shadow of the nation state only by examining the mechanisms that have empowered cities in the last few decades can we understand their new functions and capabilities in global politics

drawing together international experts on research methods in international relations in this handbook answers the complex practical questions for those approaching a new research topic for the first time innovative in its approach it considers the art of IR research as well as the science offering diverse perspectives on current research methods and emerging developments in the field

this work provides a thorough examination of research on the problem of change in the international arena and the reasons why change happens peacefully at times and at others violently it contains over forty chapters which examine the historical theoretical global regional and national foreign policy dimensions of peaceful change as the world enters a new round of power transition conflict involving a rapidly rising China and a relatively declining United States this handbook provides a necessary resource for decisionmakers and scholars engaged in this vital area of research

there is a widening divide between the data tools and knowledge that international relations scholars produce and what policy practitioners find relevant for their work in this first of its kind conversation leading academics and practitioners reflect on the nature and size of the theory practice divide they find the gap varies by issue area and over time the essays in this volume use data gathered by the Teaching Research and International Policy Project over a fifteen year period as a whole the volume analyzes the structural factors that affect the academy's ability to influence policy across issue areas and the professional incentives that affect scholars' willingness to attempt to do so individual chapters explore these questions in the areas of trade finance human rights development environment nuclear weapons and strategy interstate war and intrastate conflict each substantive chapter is followed by a response from a policy practitioner providing their perspective on the gap and the possibility for academic work to have an impact bridging the theory practice divide in international relations provides concrete answers and guidance about how and when scholarship can be policy relevant

meant primarily for students studying international relations aspirants of civil services international relations today concepts and applications captures the drastic changes in international relations after the disintegration of the Soviet Union and the end of the Cold War in 1991 it also examines the rise of China as a major military and economic power and the potential of Russia India and Germany as tomorrow's big powers it will also be useful for those interested in the discipline

metaphors constitute a fundamental way in which humans understand the world around them this book offers a comprehensive analysis of metaphors in theories of international relations until recently conscious attention to metaphors in theories of international relations has been haphazard and sporadic this book examines the metaphors that inform the major paradigms in international relations theory readers will discover that the vast majority of the terminology cataloguing defining and naming theories concepts and analytical tools pertaining to the study of international relations are metaphorical in nature the book concludes that metaphors are an essential element in all aspects of international relations theory

this book brings together a group of leading scholars on international relations to develop and apply the concept of polarity on past and present international relations and discuss its applicability and usefulness in the future despite a comprehensive debate on a global power shift often discussed in terms of the decline of the united states the crisis in the liberal international order and the rise of china its main concept of power polarity remains undertheorized and understudied the great powers and their importance for dynamics and processes in the international system are central to current debates on international order but these debates too often suffer from a combination of politicized empirical analysis and reliance on old theoretical debates and conceptualizations typically originating in the cold war security environment in order to meet these challenges this book updates conceptualizes applies and critically debates the concepts of unipolarity bipolarity multipolarity and non polarity in order to understand the current world order

international relations are generally understood as a realm of anarchy in which countries lack any superior authority and interact within a hobbesian state of nature in hierarchy in international relations david lake challenges this traditional view demonstrating that states exercise authority over one another in international hierarchies that vary historically but are still pervasive today revisiting the concepts of authority and sovereignty lake offers a novel view of international relations in which states form social contracts that bind both dominant and subordinate members the resulting hierarchies have significant effects on the foreign policies of states as well as patterns of international conflict and cooperation focusing largely on u s led hierarchies in the contemporary world lake provides a compelling account of the origins functions and limits of political order in the modern international system the book is a model of clarity in theory research design and the use of evidence motivated by concerns about the declining international legitimacy of the united states following the iraq war hierarchy in international relations offers a powerful analytic perspective that has important implications for understanding america's position in the world in the years ahead

questions and methods how then can we make sense of this and understand the field as a whole rather than simply learn one part of it this handbook is designed to address precisely this concern it maps the shifting boundaries and diverse theoretical commitments of ipe around the world it engages the geographical and theoretical diversity of the different versions of ipe found in north america the uk in asia and australia and notes the absences of distinctive versions of ipe in europe and latin america the volume groups together the essential attributes and positions of each school inviting the reader to engage with and learn about ipe in all of its guises through this evolving global conversation rather than adjudicate the one true version of ipe it argues that the intellectual diversity we see around the world is an essential and positive feature of the field with over twenty contributors from a wide range of countries routledge handbook of international political economy is an essential resource for all those with an interest in this complex and rapidly evolving field of study

this exciting new textbook challenges the implicit notions inherent in most existing international relations ir scholarship and instead presents the subject as seen from different vantage points in the global south divided into four sections 1 the ir discipline 2 key concepts and categories 3 global issues and 4 ir futures it examines the ways in which world politics have been addressed by traditional core approaches and explores the limitations of these treatments for understanding both southern and northern experiences of the international the book encourages readers to consider how key ideas have been developed in the discipline and through systematic interventions by contributors from around the globe aims at both transforming and enriching the dominant terms of scholarly debate this empowering critical and reflexive tool for thinking about the diversity of experiences of international relations and for placing them front and center in the classroom will help professors and students in both the global north and the global south envision the world differently in addition to general introductory ir courses at both the undergraduate and graduate levels it will appeal to courses on sociology and historiography of knowledge globalization neoliberalism security the state imperialism and international political economy

international relations ir theory has seen a proliferation of competing and increasingly trenchant worldviews with no consensus on how to evaluate their relative strengths and weakness this innovative new text provides an original interpretation of how best to navigate the clash of perspectives in contemporary ir theory the book provides a systematic overview of the main worldviews such as realism liberalism and constructivism and their associated theoretical underpinnings placing liberal internationalism at the heart of the debate it argues that the main division in ir theory is between liberal internationalism and its critics griffiths examines both the strengths and weaknesses of liberal internationalism as a worldview and also explores the competing worldviews that have been generated by the perceived flaws of this perspective examination of crucial policy issues is incorporated throughout the text restoring the relevance of theory for those who wish to understand those policy issues moreover this book revitalises the *raison d'être* of contemporary ir theory and shows the role it can play in making sense of the twenty first century

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
