john hodgkin before 1633 1681 2 was born in essex england he was living at guilford connecticut by 1642 he married mary bishop 1652 after 1687 daughter of john and susanna goldham bishop at guilford they had five children 1671 1677 he died at guilford or madison connecticut descendants spelled their surname hodgkin hochkin hotchkin and other varient spellings they lived in connecticut new york michigan and elsewhere

thomas loveland emigrated from england to wethersfield connecticut in 1636 and died after 1717 descendants lived in new england new york the midwest and elsewhere

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
