this book explores the relationship between transnational and local islam as expressed in public discourse and policy making as represented in the local press it does so against the background of local governments in majority muslim regions across indonesia promoting and passing regulations that mandate forms of social or economic behaviour seen to be compatible with islam the book situates the political construction of islamic behaviour in west sumatra and in indonesia more
