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gordon korman s newest stand alone novel featuring greenwich middle school s class of outcasts and miscreants the unteachables in the multiple narrator format that gordon perfected in *ungifted* and *supergifted* this book tells the story of greenwich middle school s class scs 8 a k a the unteachables the unteachables are a wayward medley of characters parker the dyslexic farm boy aldo who is perpetually angry elaine rhymes with pain barnstorm the jock rahim the sleep deprived artist and mateo lost in fantasy worlds plus kiana who is just in town visiting her dad and isn t even registered with the school not to mention their teacher mr ribbit er mr kermit who remains in disgrace after a 25 year old cheating scandal and is just killing time doing crossword puzzles and waiting to take early retirement at the end of the year are they really incorrigible or is it possible they are just misunderstood this unlikely group of heroes is about to find out for themselves

the worst class of kids in school is paired with the worst teacher and they end up saving each other

it s the unteachables meets i robot in another funny middle school tale from gordon korman it s the start of a new school year and oliver is looking forward to a seventh grade year full of spitballs jokes and pranks with his friend nathan and their new homeroom teacher mr aidact looks like a prime target he s an odd duck with a weird stilted vocabulary an unusual way of looking at things and a strangely old student teacher constantly in tow he also has a seemingly superhuman ability to detect and defuse almost every one of oliver s schemes but that s not all of it mr aidact seems to be teaching pretty much every subject he s willing to take over jobs no other teacher will like supervising detention and coaching the field hockey team oliver and nathan are determined to find out what is up with this guy what they uncover is out of this world mr aidact is in fact superhuman he s an android a secret project of the department of education and when the secret leaks out the school and the pta are in an uproar and calls for his deactivation are loud and clear can oliver and his friends turn this plan around and save the teacher they ve grown to love and appreciate

don t care high it s more than a nickname it s a concept at don carey high school school spirit is so non existent that nobody even noticed when a highway on ramp got built over the football field but new students paul and sheldon have a plan to wake the school up and don t care high will never be the same totally off the wall but always good natured this hysterically funny book is not to be missed

mayhem breaks out in the fifth grade when the venice menace bullies his classmates into letting him become a regular guest on kidsview the school s radio program

i want to go home is the story of a boy s various escape attempts from camp algonkian rudy miller is sent to camp algonkian by his parents on the misguided advice of the school guidance counselor there rudy is determined to become his own man by making snide comments of the camp founder s bow legs playing chess instead of the scheduled activities or making a saladé for his counselor at night instead of singing campfire songs rudy spends his time planning various escapes from the camp when a badly planned wager leaves rudy in charge of the camp for a day the campers will either kill him or call him a hero our novel studies provide a teacher and student section with a variety of activities discussion questions and answer key to create a well rounded lesson plan
