defenses of northern england against renewed scottish raiding the experience of english widows created by the battle to secure their rights and the cautious attempts at diplomacy including arrangements made for the exchange of prisoners undertaken in the months that followed finally bruce s parliament at cambuskenneth abbey in november 1314 is discussed alongside how the gradual redistribution of lands that this facilitated shaped the history of scotland for the remainder of the fourteenth century
