when president habyarimana s jet was shot down in april 1994 rwanda erupted into a hundred day orgy of killing which left up to a million dead fergal keane travelled through the country as the genocide was continuing and his powerful analysis reveals the terrible truth behind the headlines a tender angry account as well as being a scathing indictment keane says the genocide inflicted on the tutsis was planned well in advance by hutu leaders this is a graphic view of news gathering in extremis it deserves to become a classic independent

rwanda this small country located in the center of africa was filled with human blood in 1994 extremist rwandans killed about 1 million people in only one hundred days about 3 million fled rwanda into exile in democratic republic of congo ex zaire where they would be killed by the rwandan patriotic army from 1996 until 1998 this book is about a testimony of two boys who survived these massacres in which they had lost both their parents who were killed in the forests of the congo the older boy 7 years old at that time had to take care of his little brother a newborn whose mother was killed only a couple hours after his birth miraculously they both traveled the entire country of the congo and came back to rwanda once in their home country of rwanda in their own home village the neighbours who wanted to keep their inheritance accused them of committing genocide in 1994 but at the time of this heinous crime the older brother was only 5 years old and his little brother was not born yet to survive the attacks harassment and terror of these neighbours ancient refugees from uganda they became street kids where i met them

in 1994 more than 800 000 people were slain in the small african country of rwanda this anthology brings together a variety of viewpoints that debate the causes of this genocide the world s reaction to these events and the rebuilding of this scarred nation

britain s hidden role in the rwandan genocide examines the role of the united kingdom as a global elite bystander to the crime of genocide and its complicity in violation of international criminal laws during the rwandan genocide of 1994 as prevailing accounts confine themselves to the role and actions of the united states and the united nations the full picture of rwanda s

genocide has yet to be revealed hazel cameron demonstrates that it is the unravelling of the criminal role and actions of the british that illuminates a more detailed answer to the question of why the genocide in rwanda occurred in this book she provides a systematic and detailed analysis of the policies of the british government towards civil unrest in rwanda throughout the 1990s that culminated in genocide utilising documentary evidence obtained as a result of freedom of information requests to the foreign and commonwealth office as well as material obtained through extensive interviews with british government cabinet members diplomats ambassadors to the united nations security council prisoners in rwanda convicted of being leaders and organisers of genocide and victims and survivors of genocide in rwanda the author finds that the actions of the british and french governments both before and during the rwandan genocide of 1994 were disassociated from human rights norms it is suggested herein that the decision making of the major government during the period of 1990 1994 was for the advancement of the interrelated goals of maintaining power status and ensuring economic interests in key areas of africa this account of the legal culpability of the powerful within the corridors of government in both london and paris shows that these behaviours cannot be conceptualised under existing notions of state crime this book serves to illuminate the inadequacies and limitations of a concept of state crime in international law as it currently stands and will be of considerable interest to anyone concerned with the misuse of state power

the author talks about the testimony of two boys who successively lost their parents during the massacres in the republic democratic of congo drc former mobutu s zaire the older is an eleven year old boy and his little brother is four i have been orphaned for four years upon their return to rwanda from exile they had to flee again from their village where their lands and houses have been seized by new settlers who accused them as genocide perpetrators they have to live in the street with other kids they consider their brothers and sisters in his own words the elder boy says i have never had much opportunity in life you will be able to guess why later i am a street kid a mayibobo in my native language my address as well as my cell phone number because everyone needs a cell phone number is zero definitely zero i spend my nights under the bridges of kigali or under the canopy of

high rises when the police aren't mean and chase me away i live perched like a bird my street companions aren't friends in the sense that i would share my food with them but they are my comrades we were fleeing death without realizing that he moved with us or behind us dressed in denim pants plastic boots and kepis and speaking kinyarwanda swahili or english these soldiers were so cruel instead of attacking the people who had the strength to run away they usually started with the weak who lagged behind this would include pregnant mothers children separated from their parents the old and the sick
