in the early 1990s the department of the army abandoned its skill qualification test set

program due primarily to maintenance development and administration costs this left a void in the army s capabilities for assessing job performance qualification to meet this need the u s army research institute for the behavioral and social sciences arl institute instituted a 3 year program of feasibility research related to the development of a soldier assessment system that is both effective and affordable the performm21 program has two mutually supporting tracks the first focuses on the design of a testing program and identification of issues related to its implementation the second track is a demonstration of concept starting with a prototype core assessment targeted to all soldiers eligible for promotion to sergeant followed by job specific prototype assessments for several military occupational specialties mos the prototype assessments were developed during the first 2 years of the research program the present report describes work conducted in the final year of the performm21 program in which five prototype mos specific assessments along with the common core examination were pilot tested on a sample of specialists corporals stinet

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
