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most wesleyan holiness churches started in the us developing out of the methodist roots of the nineteenth century holiness movement the american origins of the holiness movement have been charted in some depth but there is currently little detail on how it developed outside of the us this book seeks to redress this imbalance by giving a history of north american wesleyan holiness churches in australia from their establishment in the years following the second world war as well as of the salvation army which has nineteenth century british origins it traces the way some of these churches moved from marginalised sects to established denominations while others remained small and isolated looking at the

church of god anderson the church of god cleveland the church of the nazarene the salvation army and the wesleyan methodist church in australia the book argues two main points firstly it shows that rather than being american imperialism at work these religious expressions were a creative partnership between like minded evangelical christians from two modern nations sharing a general cultural similarity and set of religious convictions secondly it demonstrates that it was those churches that showed the most willingness to be theologically flexible even dialling down some of their wesleyan distinctiveness that had the most success this is the first book to chart the fascinating development of holiness churches in australia as such it will be of keen interest to scholars of wesleyans and methodists as well as religious history and the sociology of religion more generally

drawing on and piecing together a trove of previously unexamined sources this work is a critical study of the renowned african american gospel singer mahalia jackson 1911 1972

how black musicians and composers used their craft to define and influence public discourse this groundbreaking work examines how black music functions as rhetoric considering its subject not merely reflective of but central to african american public discourse author musician and scholar earl h brooks argues that there would have been no harlem renaissance civil rights movement or black arts movement as we know these phenomena without black music through rhetorical studies archival research and musical analysis brooks establishes the sonic lexicon of black music defined by a distinct constellation of sonic and auditory features that bridge cultural linguistic and political spheres with music genres of black music such as blues and jazz are discursive fields where swinging improvisation call and response blue notes and other musical idioms serve as rhetorical tools to articulate the feelings emotions and states of mind that have shaped african american cultural and political development examining the resounding artistry of iconic musicians such as scott joplin mary lou williams duke ellington john coltrane and mahalia jackson this work offers an alternative register in which these musicians and composers are heard as public intellectuals consciously invested in crafting rhetorical projects they knew would influence the public sphere

sanctuaries of segregation the story of the jackson church visit campaign provides the first comprehensive analysis of the jackson mississippi church visit campaign of 1963 1964 and the efforts by segregationists to protect their final sanctuary for ten months integrated groups of ministers and laypeople attempted to attend sunday worship services at all white protestant and catholic churches in the state s capital city while the church visit was a common tactic of activists in the early 1960s jackson was the only city where groups mounted a sustained campaign targeting a wide variety of white churches carter dalton lyon situates the visits within the context of the jackson movement church visits and kneel ins in other cities and controversies over race within churches and denominations he then traces the campaign from its inception in early june 1963 through easter sunday 1964 highlighting the motivations of the various people and organizations the interracial dialogue that took place on the church steps the divisions and turmoil created within churches and denominations by the campaign the decisions by individual congregations to exclude black visitors and the efforts by the state and the citizens council to thwart the integration attempts sanctuaries of segregation provides a unique perspective of how a church community and individual church people reacted to civil rights activists and the movement as a whole during those tumultuous years provided by publisher

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
