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in this second edition of a guide to dissection of the human body certain dissecting instructions have been revised to increase clarity methodical and comprehensive the guide complements various anatomy courses the terminology has been checked and brought up to date in accordance with the latest version of terminologia anatomica 1998 the major aim of this guide remains to provide a well rounded dissecting manual that reinforces but does not replace a textbook of

human anatomy the details of human anatomy covered here are of interest and importance primarily in a medical context to this end the guide has been designed for medical dental osteopathy and physiotherapy students and for students of alternative medicine where dissection of the human body is required it has also been planned for postgraduate students proceeding to specialise in the various clinical surgical radiological emergency medical and gynaecological sciences and thus need to revise their anatomical knowledge through dissection it has to be stressed learning anatomy is most efficient and retention is highest when didactic study is combined with the experience of dissection in using this method one observes palpates and moves parts of the body it is a three dimensional and visuo tactile approach to the examination of the human body undoubtedly dissection reinforces and expands the knowledge gained from the textbook and from atlases and computerized anatomy programs the guide is flexible enough for use in long as well as short courses and is thus structured in such a way that the dissection of the body can be completed in 100 to 160 hours it provides a link to real living and variable anatomy

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until 1832 when an act of parliament began to regulate the use of bodies for anatomy in Britain public dissection was regularly and legally carried out on the bodies of murderers and a shortage of cadavers gave rise to the infamous murders committed by Burke and Hare to supply dissection subjects to Dr Robert Knox the anatomist this book tells the scandalous story of how medical men obtained the corpses upon which they worked before the use of human remains was regulated Helen Macdonald looks particularly at the activities of British surgeons in nineteenth century Van Diemen's Land a penal colony in which a ready supply of bodies was available not only convicted murderers but also aborigines and the unfortunate poor who died in hospitals were routinely turned over to the surgeons this sensitive but searing account shows how abuses happen even within the conventions adopted by civilized societies it reveals how from Burke and Hare to today's televised dissections by German anatomist Dr Gunther von Hagens some people's bodies become other people's entertainment

this book challenges the assumption that morphological data are inherently unsuitable for phylogeny reconstruction argues that both molecular and morphological phylogenies should play a major role in systematics and provides the most comprehensive review of the comparative anatomy homologies and evolution of the head neck pectoral and upper limb muscles of primates chapters 1 and 2 provide an introduction to the main aims and methodology of the book chapters 3 and 4 and appendices i and ii present the data obtained from dissections of the head neck pectoral and upper limb muscles of representative members of all the major primate groups including modern humans and compare these data with the information available in the literature appendices i and ii provide detailed textual attachments innervation function variations and synonyms and visual high quality photographs information about each muscle for the primate taxa included in the cladistic study of chapter 3 thus providing the first comprehensive and up to date overview of the comparative anatomy of the head neck pectoral and upper limb muscles of primates the most parsimonious tree obtained from the cladistic analysis of 166 head neck pectoral and upper limb muscle characters in 18 primate genera and in representatives of the scandentia dermoptera and rodentia is fully congruent with the evolutionary molecular tree of primates thus supporting the idea that muscle characters are particularly useful to infer phylogenies the combined anatomical materials provided in this book point out that modern humans have fewer head neck pectoral and upper limb muscles than most other living primates but are consistent with the proposal that facial and vocal communication and specialized thumb movements have probably played an important role in recent human evolution this book will be of interest to primatologists comparative anatomists functional morphologists zoologists physical anthropologists and systematians as well as to medical students physicians and researchers interested in understanding the origin evolution homology and variations of the muscles of modern humans contains 132 color plates

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
