the classic thriller behind the oscar winning movie fbi trainee clarice starling has an elusive serial killer to hunt only one man can help psychopathic cannibal hannibal lecter the serial killer nicknamed buffalo bill has been capturing and starving women then murdering and skinning them fbi rookie clarice starling is assigned to solicit help from imprisoned psychopath dr hannibal the cannibal lecter whose insight into the depraved minds of serial killers is second to none but in exchange for inviting her into the darkest chambers of his mind hannibal begins to probe at hers demanding knowledge of her childhood demons as the price of understanding buffalo bill s clarice knows how dangerous this man is and the terrible things he can do with this information but women are still disappearing and time is running out

a serial killer is at large all investigations have drawn a blank until the fbi decide to set a thief to catch a thief the only man who can help them is the cannibal serial killer dr hannibal lecter a virtual textbook on the craft of suspense a masterpiece of sheer momentum that rockets seamlessly toward its climax harris is quite simply the best suspense novelist working today the washington post

sixteen philosophers come at hannibal the way he comes at his victims from unexpected angles and with plenty of surprises thrown in hannibal is a revolting monster and yet a monster with whom we identify because of his intelligence artistry and personal magnetism the chapters in this book pose many questions and offer intriguing answers about the enigma of hannibal lecter what does the relationship between hannibal and those who know him particularly fbi investigator will graham tell us about the nature of friendship and hannibal s capacity for friendship does hannibal confer benefits on society by eliminating people who don t live up to his high aesthetic standards can upsetting experiences in early childhood turn you into a serial killer why are we enthralled by someone who exercises god like control over situations and people does it make any difference morally that a killer eats his victims can a murder be a work of art several chapters look at the mind of this accomplished killer psychiatrist and gourmet cook is he a sociopath or a psychopath or are these the same is he lacking in empathy apparently not since he has a quick understanding of what other people think and feel maybe what he lacks is a conscience

detecting men examines the history of the hollywood detective genre and the ways that detective films have negotiated changing social attitudes toward masculinity heroism law enforcement and justice genre film can be a site for the expression and resolution of problematic social issues but while there have been many studies of such other male genres as war films gangster films and westerns relatively little attention has been paid to detective films beyond film noir in this volume philippa gates examines classical films of the thirties and forties as well as recent examples of the genre including die hard the lethal weapon films the usual suspects seven devil in a blue dress and murder by numbers in order to explore social anxieties about masculinity and crime and hollywood s conceptions of gender up until the early 1990s gates argues the primary focus of the detective genre was the masculinity of the hero however from the mid 1990s onward the genre has shifted to more technical portrayals of crime scene investigation forensic science and criminal profiling offering a reassuring image of law enforcement in the face of violent crime by investigating the evolution of the detective film gates suggests perhaps we can detect the male
