in care homes for older people those responsible for workers in an induction period have been tasked to train and assess new workers who have had no prior training workers whose prior training needs to be supplemented with an induction to the specific needs of a new workplace pathways to care common induction standards is a resource to help in this training and assessment it is designed to be retained by the manager or trainer who can photocopy material from it for use by the workers part one contains not just the standards but also helpful prompts for both trainers and learners and provides much of the knowledge required by new entrants and existing workers to achieve the cis outcomes part two contains 70 pages of question sheets which like the standards and information sheets in part one can be photocopied and handed out to workers they enable inductees understanding to be checked and can help managers confirm to the commission for social care inspection that adequate induction training is being given

supporting positive behaviour examines the underlying reasons for behaviour that challenges ways to spot challenges before they occur and strategies to minimise or prevent incidents this interactive workbook will help staff to understand appropriate interventions and implement strategies that will reduce the behaviours over time

the oecd nuclear energy agency nea first published in 2000 nuclear education and training cause for concern which highlighted significant issues in the availability of human resources for the nuclear industry ten years on nuclear education and training from concern to capability considers what has changed in that time and finds that while some countries have taken positive actions in a number of others human resources could soon be facing serious challenges in coping with existing and potential new nuclear facilities this is exacerbated by the increasing rate of retirement as the workforce ages this report provides a qualitative characterisation of human resource needs and appraises instruments and programmes in nuclear education and training initiated by various stakeholders in different countries in this context it also examines the current and future uses of nuclear research facilities for education and training purposes regarding the nuclear training component of workforce competence it outlines a job taxonomy which could be a basis for addressing the needs of workers across this sector it presents the taxonomy as a way of enhancing mutual recognition and increasing consistency of education and training for both developed and developing countries

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
