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kinetic friction also known as dynamic friction or sliding friction occurs when two objects are moving relative to each other and rub together like a sled on the ground

feb 17 2023 the constant of proportionality is called the friction coefficient or coefficient of friction μ unlike other proportionality constant it does take a constant value and has no unit

friction is a force between two surfaces that are sliding or trying to slide across each other for example when you try to push a book along the floor friction makes this difficult

feb 8 2025 friction force can be calculated using the friction formula $f = \mu n$ where μ is the coefficient of friction and n is the normal force it plays a crucial role

much of the friction is actually due to attractive forces between molecules making up the two objects so that even perfectly smooth surfaces are not friction free

traditionally physicists describe three types of frictional force static friction kinetic friction and rolling friction static friction is at work when the object is stationary kinetic friction is at work when the

static friction is friction between two or more solid objects that are not moving relative to each other for example static friction can prevent an object from sliding down a sloped surface the coefficient of
