book were the size of a grain of sand the entire universe could only hold a fraction of the books in the library indeed if each book were the size of a proton our universe would still not be big enough to hold anywhere near all the books given borges well known affection for mathematics this exploration of the story through the eyes of a humanistic mathematician makes a unique and important contribution to the body of borgesian criticism bloch not only illuminates one of the great short stories of modern literature but also exposes the reader including those more inclined to the literary world to many intriguing and entrancing mathematical ideas
